HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 67

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING MS.  
2 MONICA DONOHUE FOR BEING SELECTED AS INSTRUCTOR OF THE YEAR AT THE
