- 5 industrial process by which a previously sold, leased, used, worn,
- 6 remanufactured, or nonfunctional product or part is returned to a
- 7 like-new, same-as-when-new, or better-than-when-new condition,
- 8 from both a quality and performance perspective, through a
- 9 controlled, reproducible and sustainable process; and
- 10 WHEREAS, a 2012 United States International Trade Commission
- 11 (ITC) report found that remanufacturers support at least 180,000
- 12 full-time jobs in the United States; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the ITC report states that production of
- 14 remanufactured goods in the United States increased by 15 percent
- 15 from 2009 to 2011 and exports totaled \$11.2 billion annually; and
- 16 WHEREAS, remanufacturing has been recognized by leading
- 17 universities, research institutions, and manufacturers in the

- 18 United States as good for the environment for its ability to
- 19 divert end-of-life products from landfills; and
- 20 WHEREAS, by encouraging businesses, state agencies, nonprofit
- 21 organizations, schools and individuals to celebrate Reman Day
- 22 2022, we can further promote remanufacturing as environmentally
- 23 friendly and economically smart; and
- 24 WHEREAS, to focus the nation's attention on the benefits of
