| 9  | WHEREAS, with its roots tracing back to 1894, on November 10,  |
| 10 | 1922, Mr. Gregory M. Luce purchased the A&M Railroad, and the  |
| 11 | Mississippi Export Railroad (MSE) was born, and a family legacy  |
| 12 | began with the great-grandfather of the current president  |
| 13 | and CEO of Mississippi Export Railroad, Kate Luce; and   |
| 14 | WHEREAS, headquartered in Moss Point, Mississippi,   |
| 15 | Mississippi Export Railroad is a 42-mile short line railroad   |
| 16 | extending from Evanston, Mississippi, to Pascagoula, Mississippi,  |
