HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 38

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE BAY SPRINGS  
2 BULLDOGS FOOTBALL TEAM UPON WINNING THE MISSISSIPPI HIGH SCHOOL  
3 ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION CLASS 1A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.

4 WHEREAS, proving hard work and diligence are the keys to  
5 success, the Bay Springs Bulldogs Football Team captured the  
6 Mississippi High School Activities Association (MHSAA) Class 1A  
7 State Championship by beating Simmons 32-12; and

8 WHEREAS, although the game did not start well for the  
9 Bulldogs due to a fourth down punt, Simmons returned it for a  
10 touchdown to put it up 6-0 and fortunately for Bay Springs, the  
11 momentum for Simmons stopped as soon as it started; and

12 WHEREAS, the momentum-changing play of the second half came  
13 after Simmons looked to score on a potential 24-yard touchdown  
14 run, but an illegal block in the back led to the score being  
15 called back, and one play later, Bay Springs' Jamare Holiday came  
16 down with his second interception of the game, and finally, with  
17 just over two minutes left in the game, Jones put the game away  
18 with a 24-yard touchdown by scoring the two-point conversion, and



19 the Bulldogs took over the game and it led to the final score of  
20 32-12; and

21 WHEREAS, the player of the game was given to Anthony Ross,  
22 who had 20 rushes for 219 yards and two touchdowns; and

23 WHEREAS, they were superbly coached by Head Coach Dan Brady,  
24 who refined their skills in execution, and who always believed in  
25 his team as he was quoted "When I came here years ago, they  
26 couldn't finish the second half and that's all we talked about,  
27 that's what we broke it down to. Finish the mission," said Bay  
28 Springs Head Coach Dan Brady. "I'm just proud of our kids, man.  
29 There's been so many people that didn't think they could do it but  
30 all along I told them, keep pecking away,"; and
