HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 58

1 A RESOLUTION MOURNING THE LOSS AND COMMEMORATING THE LIFE AND
2 LEGACY OF MR. EDDIE JAMES STEPNEY.

3 WHEREAS, it is written in Ecclesiastes 3:1 that "To
4 everything there is a season, and a time for every purpose under
5 the Heaven," and as such, on January 12, 2022, the immaculate
6 author and finisher of our soul's destiny summoned the mortal
7 presence of dearly beloved, Mr. Eddie James Stepney, to eternal
8 rest, rendering great sorrow and loss to his family, friends and
9 community; and

10 WHEREAS, the State of Mississippi and the City of
11 Hattiesburg, Mississippi, lost a wonderful friend, loving husband
12 and father and dedicated community leader with the passing of Mr.
13 Stepney, who was born on November 26, 1957, in Hattiesburg to the
14 late Roosevelt Stepney and Cerelia Packer Stepney, and there is
15 now a hush in our hearts as we come together to pay our respects
16 to the memory of one who has been called to join that innumerable
17 heavenly caravan; and



18 WHEREAS, Eddie James Stepney was a man of uncompromised faith
19 and accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior at an early age
20 at Antioch Baptist Church under the leadership of Reverend R.W.
21 Woullard, Sr., and was ordained as a deacon under the leadership
22 of Reverend W.C. Carroll, and he now enjoys the eternal peace
23 described in Luke 2:29, "Lord, now you are letting your servant
24 depart in peace, according to your word"; and

25 WHEREAS, a 1975 graduate of Hattiesburg High School, Mr.
26 Stepney attended Jackson State University before he enlisted with
27 an elite fraternity of soldiers in the United States Army from
28 November 19, 1981, until April 19, 1984, during which time he not
29 only heroically and patriotically fought for his country as
30 commander of Post 225, but also helped many young men attend Boys
31 State and the American Legion Oratory contest; and

32 WHEREAS, the memory of Mr. Stepney, a man held in the highest
33 regard by friends and family as an inspiring and precious gift
34 from God, will continue to refresh the hearts and memories of his
35 beloved survivors: his loving wife, Jeruthia (Judy); daughter,
36 Hillary; siblings, Roosevelt Stepney, Jr., Willie (Sharon)
37 Stepney, Michael Tisdale, Tyrone (Nellie) Jackson, Vera Stepney,
38 Vickey Campbell, Phyllis Williams and Patricia (Carlton) Burkett;
39 in-laws, Nancy Knight, Rosetta Woullard and Charles Smith; and a
40 host of other relatives and friends; and

41 WHEREAS, we encourage the family to find solace from the
42 overwhelming sadness created by the earthly departure of their



43 beloved family member in Revelation 21:4, wherein is recorded,
44 "And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there
