JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 201

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION TO REAPPORTION THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
2 MISSISSIPPI IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 254, MISSISSIPPI
3 CONSTITUTION OF 1890; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

4 WHEREAS, Section 254, Mississippi Constitution of 1890,
5 requires that the Mississippi Legislature shall apportion itself
6 by joint resolution in the second year following the 1980
7 decennial census and every ten (10) years thereafter; and

8 WHEREAS, it is the responsibility and official mandate of the
9 Legislature to reapportion the state in compliance with the
10 one-person, one-vote requirement of the federal Constitution into
11 election districts as close to equal in population as permissible
12 under law; and

13 WHEREAS, to comply with the one-person, one-vote requirement,
14 the districts set out in this joint resolution shall become
15 effective for primary and general elections conducted in 2023
16 determining the membership of the 2024 Legislature and in
17 primaries, special and general elections conducted for the
18 Legislature thereafter; and



19 WHEREAS, Section 254, Mississippi Constitution of 1890,
20 provides that the Senate shall consist of not more than fifty-two
21 (52) Senators; NOW, THEREFORE,

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
23 MISSISSIPPI, That the Senate shall consist of fifty-two (52)
24 Senators who shall be elected from fifty-two (52) single-member
25 districts, composed as follows:

470 identified in this joint resolution by an asterisk that precedes

473 Committee on Reapportionment shall file with the Secretary of
474 State the Split Precinct Block List developed in conjunction with
475 the plan contained in this joint resolution that details the
476 portions of the partial or split precincts, which are contained
477 within a district by census block number, and such document duly
478 filed with the Secretary of State is hereby incorporated into and
479 shall be construed to be an integral part of this joint
480 resolution.

481 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the boundaries of the senatorial
482 districts described above shall be:



483 (a) The boundaries of the counties listed above as such
484 boundaries existed on January 1, 2022; and

485 (b) The precinct boundaries along such Senate district
486 boundaries as the precinct boundaries are contained in Census
487 Bureau's Public Law 94-171 Geographic Support Products provided
488 for use with the September 16th data deliveries officially called
489 the "2020 Census State Redistricting Data (Public Law 94-171)
490 Summary Files."

491 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That:

492 (1) This joint resolution shall be liberally construed to
493 effectuate the purposes thereof and to redistrict the Senate
494 districts of this state in compliance with constitutional
495 requirements. It is the intent of the Legislature that this joint
496 resolution, and the districts described herein, completely
497 encompass all the area within the state. It is also intended that
498 such districts contain all the inhabitants in this state. It is
499 further intended that the redistricting provided for in this joint
500 resolution results in the creation of districts that are as close
501 to equal in population as permissible under law. It is also
502 intended that no district shall contain any of the area included
503 within the description of another district.

504 (2) If the districts described in this joint resolution do
505 not carry out the purposes thereof because of unintentional
506 omissions, duplications, overlapping areas, erroneous
507 nomenclature, lack of adequate maps or descriptions of political



508 subdivisions, wards or other divisions thereof, or of their
509 boundary lines, then the Secretary of State, at the request of the
510 Chair or Vice Chairman of the Standing Joint Legislative Committee
511 on Reapportionment shall, by order, correct such omissions,
512 overlaps, erroneous nomenclature or other defects in the
513 description of districts so as to accomplish the purposes and
514 objectives of this joint resolution.

515 (3) In promulgating such orders, the Secretary of State, in
516 addition to achieving equality in the population of districts as
517 permissible under law and ensuring that all areas of the state
518 are completely and accurately encompassed in such districts, shall
519 be guided by the following standards:

520 (a) In any instance in which there is a conflict
521 between the description of a district as provided in this joint
522 resolution and the map of the Senate districts developed by the
523 Standing Joint Legislative Committee on Reapportionment in
524 conjunction with the adopted redistricting plan, the map shall
525 control; however, in instances in which the map is inconclusive,
526 the criteria provided in paragraphs (b) through (f) of this
527 subsection shall control any dispute or issue regarding the
528 composition of any Senate district;

529 (b) Gaps in the description of a district shall be
530 completed in a manner that results in a total description of the
531 district that is consonant with the description of adjacent
532 districts and results in complete contiguity of districts;



533 (c) Areas of the state included within the descriptions
534 of more than one (1) district shall be allocated to the district
535 having the lowest population;

536 (d) Areas of the state not included within the
537 descriptions of any district shall be allocated to the adjacent
538 district having the lowest population;

539 (e) In the event that the area subject to corrected
540 description or allocation as provided in paragraphs (b), (c) and
541 (d) of this subsection is of such size or contains such population
542 that its inclusion as a unit in any district would result in
543 substantial disparity in the size, shape or population of the
544 district, then the Secretary of State may allocate portions of the
545 area to two (2) or more districts; and

546 (f) In any allocation of area or correction of
547 descriptions made pursuant to this joint resolution, the Secretary
548 of State shall, consistent with the foregoing standards, preserve
549 the contiguity and compactness of districts and avoid the
550 unnecessary division of political subdivisions.

551 (4) Copies of such orders shall be filed by the Secretary of
552 State in his office and in the offices of the affected
553 commissioners of election and registrars. The Secretary of State
554 may adopt reasonable rules regulating the procedure for
555 applications for orders under this joint resolution in the manner
556 of serving and filing a notice or copy of orders relating thereto.
557 Upon the filing of an order, the description of any affected



558 district shall be deemed to have been corrected in the manner
559 provided in such order to the full extent as if the correction had
560 been contained in the original description provided in this joint
561 resolution.

562 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Standing Joint Legislative
563 Committee on Reapportionment is directed to provide all
564 information necessary to assist the counties in identifying the
565 boundaries of the districts described in this joint resolution.

566 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the redistricting contained in
567 this joint resolution shall supersede any prior redistricting, and
568 any prior redistricting shall be null and void upon the date this
569 joint resolution is effectuated.

570 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chairman and Vice Chairman
571 of the Standing Joint Legislative Committee on Reapportionment
572 shall file copies of this plan with the Mississippi Department of
573 Archives and History, the Secretary of State, the Clerk of the
574 Mississippi House of Representatives, and the Secretary of the
575 Mississippi State Senate.

576 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That if any paragraph, sentence,
577 clause, phrase or any part of this joint resolution is declared to
578 be unconstitutional or void, or if for any reason is declared to
579 be invalid or of no effect, the remaining paragraphs, sentences,
580 clauses, phrases or parts thereof shall be in no manner affected
581 thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.



582 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the redistricting of House of
583 Representatives districts and Senate districts shall be deemed to
584 be separate from each other. The invalidity of the districts of
585 one (1) house shall not affect or require the redistricting of the
586 other house.

587 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Joint Legislative Committee
588 on Compilation, Revision and Publication of Legislation is hereby
589 directed to see to it that this resolution is placed in the
590 editor's notes that follow Section 5-1-3, Mississippi Code of
591 1972.

592 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this joint resolution shall take
593 effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
