JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 202

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION TO REAPPORTION THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
2 MISSISSIPPI IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 254, MISSISSIPPI
3 CONSTITUTION OF 1890; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

4 WHEREAS, Section 254, Mississippi Constitution of 1890,
5 requires that the Mississippi Legislature shall apportion itself
6 by joint resolution in the second year following the 1980
7 decennial census and every ten (10) years thereafter; and

8 WHEREAS, it is the responsibility and official mandate of the
9 Legislature to reapportion the state in compliance with the
10 one-person, one-vote requirement of the federal Constitution into
11 election districts as close to equal in population as permissible
12 under law; and

13 WHEREAS, to comply with the one-person, one-vote requirement,
14 the districts set out in this joint resolution shall become
15 effective for primary and general elections conducted in 2023
16 determining the membership of the 2024 Legislature and in
17 primaries, special and general elections conducted for the
18 Legislature thereafter; and



19 WHEREAS, Section 254, Mississippi Constitution of 1890,
20 provides that the Senate shall consist of not more than fifty-two
21 (52) Senators; NOW, THEREFORE,

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
23 MISSISSIPPI, That the Senate shall consist of fifty-two (52)
24 Senators who shall be elected from fifty-two (52) single-member
25 districts, composed as follows:

471 identified in this joint resolution by an asterisk that precedes
472 its designation within the description of a district. The
473 Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Standing Joint Legislative
474 Committee on Reapportionment shall file with the Secretary of
475 State the Split Precinct Block List developed in conjunction with
476 the plan contained in this joint resolution that details the
477 portions of the partial or split precincts, which are contained
478 within a district by census block number, and such document duly
479 filed with the Secretary of State is hereby incorporated into and
480 shall be construed to be an integral part of this joint
481 resolution.

482 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the boundaries of the senatorial
483 districts described above shall be:



484 (a) The boundaries of the counties listed above as such
485 boundaries existed on January 1, 2022; and

486 (b) The precinct boundaries along such Senate district
487 boundaries as the precinct boundaries are contained in Census
488 Bureau's Public Law 94-171 Geographic Support Products provided
489 for use with the September 16th data deliveries officially called
490 the "2020 Census State Redistricting Data (Public Law 94-171)
491 Summary Files."

492 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That:

493 (1) This joint resolution shall be liberally construed to
494 effectuate the purposes thereof and to redistrict the Senate
495 districts of this state in compliance with constitutional
496 requirements. It is the intent of the Legislature that this joint
497 resolution, and the districts described herein, completely
498 encompass all the area within the state. It is also intended that
499 such districts contain all the inhabitants in this state. It is
500 further intended that the redistricting provided for in this joint
501 resolution results in the creation of districts that are as close
502 to equal in population as permissible under law. It is also
503 intended that no district shall contain any of the area included
504 within the description of another district.

505 (2) If the districts described in this joint resolution do
506 not carry out the purposes thereof because of unintentional
507 omissions, duplications, overlapping areas, erroneous
508 nomenclature, lack of adequate maps or descriptions of political



509 subdivisions, wards or other divisions thereof, or of their
510 boundary lines, then the Secretary of State, at the request of the
511 Chair or Vice Chairman of the Standing Joint Legislative Committee
512 on Reapportionment shall, by order, correct such omissions,
513 overlaps, erroneous nomenclature or other defects in the
514 description of districts so as to accomplish the purposes and
515 objectives of this joint resolution.

516 (3) In promulgating such orders, the Secretary of State, in
517 addition to achieving equality in the population of districts as
518 permissible under law and ensuring that all areas of the state
519 are completely and accurately encompassed in such districts, shall
520 be guided by the following standards:

521 (a) In any instance in which there is a conflict
522 between the description of a district as provided in this joint
523 resolution and the map of the Senate districts developed by the
524 Standing Joint Legislative Committee on Reapportionment in
525 conjunction with the adopted redistricting plan, the map shall
526 control; however, in instances in which the map is inconclusive,
527 the criteria provided in paragraphs (b) through (f) of this
528 subsection shall control any dispute or issue regarding the
529 composition of any Senate district;

530 (b) Gaps in the description of a district shall be
531 completed in a manner that results in a total description of the
532 district that is consonant with the description of adjacent
533 districts and results in complete contiguity of districts;



534 (c) Areas of the state included within the descriptions
535 of more than one (1) district shall be allocated to the district
536 having the lowest population;

537 (d) Areas of the state not included within the
538 descriptions of any district shall be allocated to the adjacent
539 district having the lowest population;

540 (e) In the event that the area subject to corrected
541 description or allocation as provided in paragraphs (b), (c) and
542 (d) of this subsection is of such size or contains such population
543 that its inclusion as a unit in any district would result in
544 substantial disparity in the size, shape or population of the
545 district, then the Secretary of State may allocate portions of the
546 area to two (2) or more districts; and

547 (f) In any allocation of area or correction of
548 descriptions made pursuant to this joint resolution, the Secretary
549 of State shall, consistent with the foregoing standards, preserve
550 the contiguity and compactness of districts and avoid the
551 unnecessary division of political subdivisions.

552 (4) Copies of such orders shall be filed by the Secretary of
553 State in his office and in the offices of the affected
554 commissioners of election and registrars. The Secretary of State
555 may adopt reasonable rules regulating the procedure for
556 applications for orders under this joint resolution in the manner
557 of serving and filing a notice or copy of orders relating thereto.
558 Upon the filing of an order, the description of any affected



559 district shall be deemed to have been corrected in the manner
560 provided in such order to the full extent as if the correction had
561 been contained in the original description provided in this joint
562 resolution.

563 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Standing Joint Legislative
564 Committee on Reapportionment is directed to provide all
565 information necessary to assist the counties in identifying the
566 boundaries of the districts described in this joint resolution.

567 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the redistricting contained in
568 this joint resolution shall supersede any prior redistricting, and
569 any prior redistricting shall be null and void upon the date this
570 joint resolution is effectuated.

571 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chairman and Vice Chairman
572 of the Standing Joint Legislative Committee on Reapportionment
573 shall file copies of this plan with the Mississippi Department of
574 Archives and History, the Secretary of State, the Clerk of the
575 Mississippi House of Representatives, and the Secretary of the
576 Mississippi State Senate.

577 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That if any paragraph, sentence,
578 clause, phrase or any part of this joint resolution is declared to
579 be unconstitutional or void, or if for any reason is declared to
580 be invalid or of no effect, the remaining paragraphs, sentences,
581 clauses, phrases or parts thereof shall be in no manner affected
582 thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.



583 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the redistricting of House of
584 Representatives districts and Senate districts shall be deemed to
585 be separate from each other. The invalidity of the districts of
586 one (1) house shall not affect or require the redistricting of the
587 other house.

588 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Joint Legislative Committee
589 on Compilation, Revision and Publication of Legislation is hereby
590 directed to see to it that this resolution is placed in the
591 editor's notes that follow Section 5-1-3, Mississippi Code of
592 1972.

593 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this joint resolution shall take
594 effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
