## SENATE BILL NO. 2043

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-6-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PRESCRIBE THE SALARY FOR LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS BASED ON SCHOOL DISTRICT STUDENT ENROLLMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-6-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 37-6-13. (1) (a) Until July 1, 2022, each person serving
- 8 as a member of the school board of any school district shall
- 9 receive per diem in the amount of Sixty-seven Dollars (\$67.00) for
- 10 no more than thirty-six (36) meetings of the school board during
- 11 any one (1) fiscal year or, in his or her discretion, irrevocably
- 12 may choose to receive as compensation for his or her services an
- 13 annual salary in the amount of Two Thousand Four Hundred Dollars
- 14 (\$2,400.00), which choice shall remain in force for all successive
- 15 terms or periods of service of that member.
- 16 (b) Effective July 1, 2022, the salary for school board
- 17 members shall be determined by the number of students enrolled in

18	the school district as of October 1 in each fiscal year as

20	The school board members' annual salary shall be:
21	(i) Three Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$3,600.00)
22	for school districts with an enrollment up to five thousand

25	for school districts with an enrollment from five thousand (5,000)
26	up to ten thousand (10,000) students;
