## SENATE BILL NO. 2048

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-6-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 PRESCRIBE THE SALARY FOR LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS BASED ON 3 SCHOOL DISTRICT STUDENT ENROLLMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 37-6-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6 7 37-6-13. (1) (a) Until July 1, 2022, each person serving as a member of the school board of any school district shall 8 9 receive per diem in the amount of Sixty-seven Dollars (\$67.00) for no more than thirty-six (36) meetings of the school board during 10 any one (1) fiscal year or, in his or her discretion, irrevocably 11 may choose to receive as compensation for his or her services an 12 13 annual salary in the amount of Two Thousand Four Hundred Dollars 14 (\$2,400.00), which choice shall remain in force for all successive terms or periods of service of that member. 15

16 (b) Effective July 1, 2022, the salary for school board 17 members shall be determined by the number of students enrolled in

18 the school district as of October 1 in each fiscal year as 19 follows: 20 The school board members annual salary shall be: 21 (i) Three Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$3,600.00) 22 for school districts with an enrollment up to five thousand 23 (5,000) students; 24 (ii) Four Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$4,200.00) 25 for school districts with an enrollment from five thousand (5,000) 26 up to ten thousand (10,000) students; 27 (iii) Four Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars 28 (\$4,800.00) for school districts with an enrollment from ten 29 thousand (10,000) to twenty thousand (20,000) students; 30 (iv) Five Thousand Four Hundred Dollars 31 (\$5,400.00) for school districts with an enrollment from twenty thousand (20,000) to thirty thousand (30,000) students; and 32 33 (v) Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00) for school 34 districts with an enrollment of over thirty thousand (30,000) 35 students. 36 The receipt of the compensation shall not entitle (C) 37 any member of a school board to receive or be eligible for any 38 state employee group insurance, retirement or other fringe 39 benefits. 40 Each member shall be reimbursed for the necessary (d) expenses and mileage in attending meetings of the school board. 41 42 In addition to the foregoing, all members may be reimbursed for S. 22/SS36/R194 PAGE 2 (scm\kr) 43 mileage and actual expenses incurred in the further performance of 44 their duties, including attendance at any mandatory school board training session or at regional and national education meetings, 45 46 when such mileage and other expenses are authorized by the board 47 prior to the date on which they occur. Detailed vouchers shall be 48 submitted for reimbursement for all expenses authorized by this Such reimbursement shall be in accordance with Section 49 section. 50 25-3-41. Such expenses shall be paid on order of the school board 51 by pay certificates issued by the superintendent of the school 52 district involved against the funds available for payment of the 53 administrative expense of the district.

54 (2)If a member of a school board misses twenty percent (a) 55 (20%) or more of the meetings of the school board during a 56 calendar year, except for absences caused by required military 57 duty, the member must reimburse the school district that portion 58 of the total salary paid to the member that year which is 59 proportionate to the number of meetings missed by the member in relation to the total number of school board meetings held during 60 61 that year. For purposes of this subsection, consideration may be 62 given only to meetings of which public notice is required.

(b) Before February 1 of each year, the president of
each local school board shall submit a report to the State Board
of Education containing the names of any members of the school
board who missed twenty percent (20%) or more of the school board
meetings during the preceding calendar year.
