SENATE BILL NO. 2077

- AN ACT TO CREATE THE "MISSISSIPPI FARMS AND FAMILIES PROGRAM"
 WHICH REQUIRES THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COMMERCE, SUBJECT
 TO APPROPRIATION, TO FUND QUALIFIED MISSISSIPPI NONPROFITS TO
 DISTRIBUTE FUNDS TO MISSISSIPPI FARMERS MARKETS AND RETAILERS FOR
 THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING MATCHING DOLLAR INCENTIVES FOR
 SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM BENEFITS SPENT ON
 ELIGIBLE FRUITS AND VEGETABLES AT FARMERS MARKETS AND RETAILERS;
 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 10 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) This act shall be known and may be cited as
 11 the "Mississippi Farms and Families Program."
- 12 (2) Subject to appropriation, the Mississippi Department of
- 13 Agriculture and Commerce shall fund qualified nonprofit
- 14 organizations that shall distribute incentive dollars to
- 15 participating Mississippi farmers markets and retailers for
- 16 developing a nutrition incentive program to double the purchasing
- 17 power of Mississippi residents with limited access to fresh fruits
- 18 and vegetables, support farmers, and invest in Mississippi's local
- 19 economy.
- 20 (3) The designated nonprofit organizations shall have a

- 26 farmers markets, produce stands, and direct producer-to-consumer

- 28 (d) Conducting community outreach and data collection;

- 30 (e) Providing full accounting and administration of
- 31 funds distributed to farmers markets and retailers.
- 32 (4) At least ninety percent (90%) of the money deposited
- 33 into the Mississippi Farms and Families Program shall be
- 34 distributed to participating Mississippi farmers markets, produce
- 35 stands, and retailers for healthy food incentives. A maximum of
- 36 ten percent (10%) of the money deposited into the Mississippi
- 37 Farms and Families Program may be used for administrative costs.
- 38 (5) Guidelines and eligibility for the Mississippi Farms and
- 39 Families Program shall be established by the Department of
- 40 Agriculture, consistent with the U.S. Agriculture Improvement Act
- 41 of 2018. For the purposes of this program, "eligible fruits and
- 42 vegetables" means any fresh or frozen, whole or cut fruits and
- 43 vegetables that do not contain added sugar, fat, oil or salt.
- 44 "Eligible retailers" means a small business whose principal office
- 45 is located in Mississippi and that has a demonstrated commitment

- 46 to procuring Mississippi-grown foods, including fruits and
- 47 vegetables.
- 48 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 49 and after its passage.
