SENATE BILL NO. 2082

- AN ACT TO PHASE IN AN AD VALOREM TAX EXEMPTION ON ALL 1 2 COMMODITIES, PRODUCTS, GOODS, WARES AND MERCHANDISE HELD FOR 3 RESALE BY ANY SMALL BUSINESS WITH AN ANNUAL NET REVENUE OF LESS THAN \$2,000,000.00; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, the term "small
- 7 business" means any commercial enterprise with an annual net
- revenue of less than Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00). 8
- (2) From and after January 1, 2023, through December 31, 9
- 10 2023, twenty percent (20%) of the assessed value of all
- commodities, products, goods, wares and merchandise held for 11
- 12 resale by any small business shall be exempt from ad valorem
- 13 taxation.
- 14 (3) From and after January 1, 2024, through December 31,
- 2024, forty percent (40%) of the assessed value of all 15
- commodities, products, goods, wares and merchandise held for 16
- 17 resale by any small business shall be exempt from ad valorem
- 18 taxation.

- 19 (4) From and after January 1, 2025, through December 31,
- 20 2025, sixty percent (60%) of the assessed value of all
- 21 commodities, products, goods, wares and merchandise held for
- 22 resale by any small business shall be exempt from ad valorem
- 23 taxation.
- 24 (5) From and after January 1, 2026, through December 31,
- 25 2026, eighty percent (80%) of the assessed value of all
- 26 commodities, products, goods, wares and merchandise held for
- 27 resale by any small business shall be exempt from ad valorem
- 28 taxation.
- 29 (6) From and after January 1, 2027, all commodities,
- 30 products, goods, wares and merchandise held for resale by any
- 31 small business shall be exempt from ad valorem taxation.
- 32 **SECTION 2.** Nothing in this act shall affect or defeat any
- 33 claim, assessment, appeal, suit, right or cause of action for
- 34 taxes due or accrued under the ad valorem tax laws before the date
- 35 on which this act becomes effective or before the date an increase
- 36 in the exemption authorized by this act becomes effective, whether
- 37 such claims, assessments, appeals, suits or actions have been
- 38 begun before the date on which this act or an increase in the
- 39 exemption authorized by this act becomes effective or are begun
- 40 thereafter; and the provisions of the ad valorem tax laws are
- 41 expressly continued in full force, effect and operation for the
- 42 purpose of the assessment, collection and enrollment of liens for
- 43 any taxes due or accrued and the execution of any warrant under

- 44 such laws before the date on which this act becomes effective or
- 45 any increase in the exemption authorized by this act becomes
- 46 effective and for the imposition of any penalties, forfeitures or
- 47 claims for failure to comply with such laws.
- 48 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 49 and after July 1, 2022.
