SENATE BILL NO. 2105 (As Passed the Senate)

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-6-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE COMPENSATION OF SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS <u>BASED ON THE</u> SCHOOL DISTRICTS' ENROLLMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-6-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 37-6-13. (1) Each person serving as a member of the school
- 8 board of any school district shall receive per diem in the amount
- 9 of * * * One Hundred Twelve Dollars (\$112.00) for no more than
- 10 thirty-six (36) meetings of the school board during any one (1)
- 11 fiscal year or, in his or her discretion, irrevocably may choose
- 12 to receive as compensation for his or her services an annual
- 13 salary * * *, subject to the following provisions:
- 14 (a) For a person serving as a member of the school
- 15 <u>board of a school district with less than five thousand (5,000)</u>
- 16 <u>students enrolled in the school district</u>, the person shall receive
- an annual salary of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00);

18	(b) For a person serving as a member of the school
19	board of a school district with at least five thousand (5,000)
20	students but less than ten thousand (10,000) students enrolled in
21	the school district, the person shall receive an annual salary of
22	not less than Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) but not more than
23	Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00); and
24	(c) For a person serving as a member of the school
25	board of a school district with greater than ten thousand (10,000)
26	students enrolled in the school district, the person shall receive
27	an annual salary of not less than Four Thousand Dollars
28	(\$4,000.00) but not more than Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00).
29	<u>This</u> choice shall remain in force for all successive terms or
30	periods of service of that member. The receipt of the
31	compensation shall not entitle any member of a school board to
32	receive or be eligible for any state employee group insurance,
33	retirement or other fringe benefits. Each member shall be
34	reimbursed for the necessary expenses and mileage in attending
35	meetings of the school board. In addition to the foregoing, all
36	members may be reimbursed for mileage and actual expenses incurred
37	in the further performance of their duties, including attendance
38	at any mandatory school board training session or at regional and
39	national education meetings, when such mileage and other expenses
40	are authorized by the board prior to the date on which they occur.
4 1	Detailed vouchers shall be submitted for reimbursement for all

- 42 expenses authorized by this section. Such reimbursement shall be
- 43 in accordance with Section 25-3-41.
- Such expenses shall be paid on order of the school board by
- 45 pay certificates issued by the superintendent of the school
- 46 district involved against the funds available for payment of the
- 47 administrative expense of the district.
- 48 (2) (a) If a member of a school board misses twenty percent
- 49 (20%) or more of the meetings of the school board during a
- 50 calendar year, except for absences caused by required military
- 51 duty, the member must reimburse the school district that portion
- 52 of the total salary paid to the member that year which is
- 53 proportionate to the number of meetings missed by the member in
- 54 relation to the total number of school board meetings held during
- 55 that year. For purposes of this subsection, consideration may be
- 56 given only to meetings of which public notice is required.
- 57 (b) Before February 1 of each year, the president of
- 58 each local school board shall submit a report to the State Board
- of Education containing the names of any members of the school
- 60 board who missed twenty percent (20%) or more of the school board
- 61 meetings during the preceding calendar year.
- 62 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 63 and after July 1, 2022.
