- 8 SECTION 1. Section 73-27-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 9
- 10 73-27-1. (1) The practice of podiatric medicine is that
- profession concerned with the prevention, examination, diagnosis 11
- and medical, surgical and adjuvant treatment of conditions of the 12
- 13 human foot and ankle, and their governing and related structures,
- including the muscles or tendons of the lower leg governing the 14
- 15 functions of the foot and ankle. * * *
- (2) A podiatrist is a * * * physician who engages in the 16
- practice of podiatric medicine. 17
- 18 (3) A podiatrist may prescribe and administer drugs and
- tests, excluding general and spinal anesthesia, that are essential 19
- to the practice of podiatric medicine when used for or in 20

- 21 connection with treatment of disorders of the human foot and
- 22 ankle, and their governing and related structures, including the
- 23 muscles or tendons of the lower leg governing the functions of the
- 24 foot and ankle.
- 25 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after July 1, 2022.
