SENATE BILL NO. 2223

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE 2 LICENSE TAGS TO SUPPORTERS OF THE 2021 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP 3 BULLDOGS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: **SECTION 1.** (1) Beginning with any registration year 5 commencing on or after July 1, 2022, any owner of a motor vehicle 6 7 who is a resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as 8 9 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 10 11 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor 12 13 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a 14 supporter of the 2021 National Championship Bulldogs. The 15 distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and 16 design as the Department of Revenue, with the advice of the President of Mississippi State University or his designee, may 17 18 prescribe and shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both,

19 as may be necessary to distinguish each license tag. The 20 President of Mississippi State University or his designee shall 21 choose the first one hundred (100) tag numbers and provide them to 22 the Department of Revenue.

23 Application for the distinctive license tags authorized (2)24 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms 25 prescribed by the Department of Revenue. The application and the 26 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less 27 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, 28 shall be remitted to the Department of Revenue on a monthly basis 29 as prescribed by the department. The portion of the additional 30 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the 31 county general fund.

32 Beginning with any registration year commencing on or (3) 33 after July 1, 2022, any person applying for a distinctive license 34 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 35 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all 36 37 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a period of time to run concurrently with the vehicle's established 38 39 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 40 time the original application is made for a distinctive license 41 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 42 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive 43

44 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax 45 collector.

(4) The Department of Revenue shall deposit all fees into
the State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each
month, the Department of Revenue shall certify to the State
Treasurer the total fees collected under this section from the
issuance of the distinctive license tags issued under this
section. The State Treasurer shall distribute such collections as
follows:

(a) Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) of each additional fee
collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
section shall be distributed to the Mississippi State University
Foundation.

57 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected 58 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall 59 be deposited into the Mississippi Burn Care Fund created pursuant 60 to Section 7-9-70.

(c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund
to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
reconstruction of highways.

66 (d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected 67 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall

70 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 71 72 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the 73 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under 74 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, 75 76 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license 77 tag.

78 In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license (6) tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and 79 80 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 81 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 82 83 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 84 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 85 for such replacement license tag, and the remainder shall be 86 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 87 distinctive license tags issued under this section.

88 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 89 and after July 1, 2022.
