SENATE BILL NO. 2245

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-29-61, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REVISE SENTENCING OPTIONS FOR THE CRIME OF VOYEURISM; AND FOR 3 RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 97-29-61, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 6 7 97-29-61. (1) (a) Any person who enters upon real property, whether the original entry is legal or not, and 8 9 thereafter pries or peeps through a window or other opening in a dwelling or other building structure for the lewd, licentious and 10 11 indecent purpose of spying upon the occupants thereof, shall be 12 guilty of a felonious trespass. 13 (b) Any person who looks through a window, hole or 14 opening, or otherwise views by means of any instrumentality, 15 including, but not limited to, a periscope, telescope, binoculars, 16 drones, camera, motion-picture camera, camcorder or mobile phone, into the interior of a bedroom, bathroom, changing room, fitting 17 18 room, dressing room, spa, massage room or therapy room or tanning

No. 2245 G1/2 22/SS26/R492 PAGE 1 (ens\tb) booth, or the interior of any other area in which the occupant has a reasonable expectation of privacy, with the intent to invade the privacy of a person or persons inside and without the consent or knowledge of every person present, for the lewd, licentious and indecent purpose of spying upon the occupant or occupants thereof, shall be guilty of a felony.

(2) (a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this
subsection, a person who * * * is over the age of * * * eighteen
(18) at the time of the offense * * * and is convicted of a
violation of subsection (1) of this section shall be imprisoned in
the custody of the Department of Corrections not more than five
(5) years.

31 (b) When one or more occupants spied upon is a child 32 under sixteen (16) years of age, a person who was over the age of 33 twenty-one (21) at the time of the offense who is convicted of a 34 violation of subsection (1) of this section shall be imprisoned in 35 the custody of the Department of Corrections not more than ten 36 (10) years.

37 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 38 and after July 1, 2022.

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
