SENATE BILL NO. 2350 (As Passed the Senate)

1 AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 41-57-33, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 2 1972, TO PROVIDE FOR THE STATE REGISTRAR TO ISSUE A CERTIFICATE OF 3 FOREIGN BIRTH WITHOUT JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS IF CERTAIN CRITERIA ARE 4 SATISFIED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section

7 41-57-33, Mississippi Code of 1972:

8 <u>41-57-33.</u> (1) A child who has automatically acquired United 9 States citizenship following a foreign adoption and who possesses 10 a Certificate of Citizenship in accordance with the Child 11 Citizenship Act, CAA, Public Law 106-395, shall be exempt from the 12 provisions of Sections 93-17-301 through 93-17-307, which provide 13 for a judicial proceeding to acquire a birth certificate following 14 certain foreign adoptions.

The State Registrar, upon written request, shall prepare 15 (2)a Certificate of Foreign Birth reflecting the actual date and 16 17 place of birth for a child who was born in a foreign country, adopted by a United States citizen, and who has automatically 18 19 acquired citizenship in accordance with the federal Child G1/2 S. 20 Citizenship Act upon the production of all of the following 21 documents:

22 The child's Certificate of Citizenship; (a) 23 A certified copy of the child's foreign birth (b) 24 certificate and certified English translation; 25 (C) The original documents related to the foreign adoption certified by the United States Embassy abroad and 26 27 certified English translation; 28 The social security card of the child; (d) 29 (e) A valid government-issued picture identification of 30 parent or parents, such as a passport or driver's license; and Proof of residency of the parent or parents in the 31 (f)

32 State of Mississippi.

33 (3) The State Registrar shall develop any necessary forms
34 for adoptive parents to submit in order to request a Certificate
35 of Foreign Birth.

36 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 37 and after July 1, 2022, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2022.
