## SENATE BILL NO. 2412

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-895, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
  TO EXTEND THE PROHIBITION ON ELECTIONEERING ACTIVITIES TO ALL
  PERSONS WITHIN THE POLLING PLACE AND IN ANY PUBLIC AREA THAT IS
  WITHIN A SET DISTANCE OF THE POLLING PLACE; TO DEFINE THE
  ACTIVITIES WHICH CONSTITUTE ELECTIONEERING; AND FOR RELATED
  PURPOSES.

  BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

  SECTION 1. Section 23-15-895, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:

23-15-895. (1) For purposes of this section, the following

- 11 terms shall be defined as follows:
- 12 <u>(a) "Polling place" means the physical place where</u>
- 13 <u>ballots and absentee ballots are cast and includes the circuit</u>
- 14 clerk's office and city hall during the period in which absentee
- 15 <u>ballots are cast.</u>

- 16 (b) "Local issue" shall have the meaning ascribed to
- 17 such term in Section 23-15-375.
- 18 (2) The following activities are prohibited within a polling
- 19 place and in any public area within one hundred fifty (150) feet
- of any operable entrance of a polling place:

21	(a) No person may make any oral, printed or written
22	attempt to persuade persons to refrain from voting, voting for or
23	voting against any candidate, constitutional amendment, local
24	issue or other measure printed on the ballot;
25	(b) No person may post or distribute cards, posters or
26	other campaign literature in support of or in opposition to any
27	candidate, constitutional amendment, local issue or other measure
28	printed on the ballot;
29	(c) No person may wear or display any apparel, badge,
30	button, pin, sticker or any other insignia which identifies by
31	name, photo or likeness any candidate, constitutional amendment,
32	local issue or other measure printed on the ballot; and
33	(d) No candidate or a representative named by him or
34	her in writing may appear at any polling place while one is armed
35	or uniformed, or displaying any badge or credentials except as may
36	be issued by the manager of the polling place.
37	(3) * * * This section shall be enforced by election
38	officials and law enforcement officials.
39	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2022.
