1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-15-64.5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO DELETE THE REQUIREMENT FOR A SALTWATER SHRIMP CAPTAIN'S LICENSE 3 ISSUED BY THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF MARINE RESOURCES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 49-15-64.5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 49-15-64.5. (1) (a) Each freight boat, ice boat and 8 9 catching boat used in catching or transporting saltwater shrimp 10 taken from the waters of the State of Mississippi for sale in their fresh state, or for canning, packing, freezing or drying, 11 12 shall first obtain from the commission an annual privilege license and pay a license fee at the following rates: 13 14 (i) Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for resident boats or vessels under thirty (30) feet in length in overall measurements 15 and One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for nonresident boats or vessels 16 17 under thirty (30) feet in length in overall measurements; (ii) Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00) for resident 18 boats or vessels between thirty (30) and forty-five (45) feet in 19 S. No. 2511 ~ OFFICIAL ~ G3/5 20 length in overall measurements and One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) 21 for nonresident boats or vessels between thirty (30) and 22 forty-five (45) feet in length in overall measurements;

(iii) One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for resident
boats or vessels greater than forty-five (45) feet in length in
overall measurements and Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for
nonresident boats or vessels greater than forty-five (45) feet in
length in overall measurements.

(b) Beginning September 15, 1994, no nonresident shall be issued a commercial fishing license under this chapter for the taking of saltwater shrimp using any type of net if that nonresident's state of domicile prohibits the issuing of commercial fishing licenses to residents of this state to engage in like activity.

34 (2) Each recreational vessel engaging in shrimping with a
 35 net having a corkline length of sixteen (16) feet or less shall
 36 pay an annual resident license fee of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) or
 37 an annual nonresident license fee of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00).

39 (***<u>3</u>) During open seasons and in open areas, saltwater
40 shrimp may be taken only with shrimp trawls, trawls, butterfly
41 nets, skimmer nets, push trawls, beach seines and cast nets.
