COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2517

1 AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 77-7-345, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 2 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO CREATE BY RULE A VOLUNTARY PROGRAM OF COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTION; 3 4 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 7 77-7-345, Mississippi Code of 1972: 8 77-7-345. (1) When not otherwise specifically provided, the 9 commissioner is authorized to make and promulgate reasonable rules 10 and regulations to provide a voluntary program for inspection of commercial motor vehicles. 11 12 (2) For the purposes of this section, "commercial motor vehicle" has the meaning ascribed in Section 63-1-203. 13 14 (3) The regulations, if promulgated, will: (a) Create a voluntary program for inspection of any 15 combination of truck, truck tractor, trailer, semi-trailer or pole 16 17 trailer, including each segment of a combined vehicle, that is 18 used upon the highways or streets as a commercial motor vehicle

21 (b) Require that inspectors have access to the vehicle 22 maintenance log;

(c) Prescribe a method of documentation to be displayed on the vehicle that is readily visible to an observer in the form of a decal or sticker, and require that the form of documentation prescribed must be kept on the vehicle;

27 (d) Require that inspection occur on an annual basis28 for participation in the program;

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(e) Provide that inspection is not mandatory;

30 (f) Impose a reasonable inspection fee, which shall be 31 deposited to the credit of the operating fund of the Commercial 32 Transportation Enforcement Division of the Mississippi Department 33 of Public Safety; and

34 (g) Specify that officers of the Commercial
35 Transportation Enforcement Division will retain all responsibility
36 and authority to monitor and enforce violations under Section
37 77-7-335.

38 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 39 and after July 1, 2022.
