SENATE BILL NO. 2563

1 AN ACT TO CRIMINALIZE THE UNAUTHORIZED POSSESSION AND 2 TRANSFER OF A PILL PRESS; TO INCLUDE SIMILAR DEVICES WITHIN THE 3 OFFENSE; TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION; TO REQUIRE 4 REGISTRATION WITH THE MISSISSIPPI BUREAU OF NARCOTICS, UNLESS THE 5 PILL PRESS IS AUTHORIZED BY THE BOARD OF PHARMACY OR OTHER LAWFUL 6 ENTITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
 <u>SECTION 1.</u> This act shall be known and referred to as the
 "Mississippi Pill Press Act of 2022."

10 SECTION 2. Possession, transfer or manufacture of a pill press; registration; penalty. (1) Unless authorized by the State 11 Board of Pharmacy, other lawful authority or this section, it is 12 13 unlawful for any person knowingly or intentionally to possess, create, sell, barter, transfer, manufacture, or distribute a pill 14 15 press, a punch, die, plate, tableting machine, encapsulating machine, or any similar pharmaceutical producing equipment, 16 knowing, intending, or having reasonable cause to believe, that it 17 18 will be used to manufacture a controlled substance or counterfeit 19 controlled substance.

No. 2563 G1/2 22/SS26/R685 20 (2)All pill presses, punches, dies, plates, tableting 21 machines, encapsulating machines or any similar pharmaceutical 22 producing equipment shall be registered with the Mississippi 23 Bureau of Narcotics, unless the pill press is authorized by the 24 Board of Pharmacy or other lawful authority. The Mississippi 25 Department of Public Safety shall promulgate rules regarding the 26 registration, transfer and destruction of such equipment and the renewal of registrations, to include inspection of all of 27 28 equipment registered and any product that the equipment is being 29 used to manufacture.

30 (3) Any person who violates this subsection shall be, if
31 convicted, imprisoned by not more than five (5) years or fined not
32 more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or both.

33 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 34 and after July 1, 2022.
