AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-973, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROHIBIT CIRCUIT JUDGES FROM ALLOWING ANY CANDIDATE FOR JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME COURT, JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS, CIRCUIT JUDGE OR CHANCELLOR TO ADDRESS THE PUBLIC DURING COURT TERMS; TO DELETE 5 THE PROHIBITION AGAINST ANY CANDIDATE FOR JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME COURT, JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS, CIRCUIT JUDGE OR CHANCELLOR 7 ALIGNING HIMSELF OR HERSELF WITH ANY CANDIDATE OR CANDIDATES FOR ANY OTHER OFFICE OR WITH ANY POLITICAL FACTION OR ANY POLITICAL 8 PARTY AT ANY TIME DURING ANY PRIMARY OR GENERAL ELECTION CAMPAIGN; 9 10 TO DELETE THE PENALTY FOR DOING SO; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 12 **SECTION 1.** Section 23-15-973, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 13 amended as follows: 14 23-15-973. * * * No judge of any circuit court may provide 15 an opportunity for any candidate for Justice of the Supreme Court, Judge of the Court of Appeals, circuit judge or chancellor to 16 17 address the public during court terms. It shall be unlawful for any candidate for any other office nominated or to be nominated at 18 any primary election, wherein any candidate for any of the 19 20 judicial offices in this section mentioned, is or are to be nominated, to align himself with any one or more of the candidates 21 22 for said offices or to take any part whatever in any nomination S.
