SENATE BILL NO. 2667

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 33-11-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
2 AUTHORIZE THE ADJUTANT GENERAL TO TRANSFER ON BEHALF OF THE STATE
3 REAL PROPERTY THAT IS IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE MILITARY
4 DEPARTMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 33-11-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7 amended as follows:

8 33-11-1. The Adjutant General of this state may receive and
9 transfer on behalf of the state * * * real property * * * that is
10 in the best interest of the Military Department. Such land may be
11 transferred for any consideration and upon such other terms and
12 conditions as the Adjutant General may deem advisable. In
13 accepting any such conveyance on behalf of the state, the state
14 shall incur no liability for the purchase of such real estate
15 unless it can be absorbed by the current appropriation for the
16 operation of the military department. The Adjutant General is
17 further empowered to enter into cooperative agreements with any
18 county, municipality, or other political subdivision, of the state



19 for the purpose of providing facilities for National Guard
20 training purposes.

21 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
22 and after July 1, 2022.
