SENATE BILL NO. 2677

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-7-104.4, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE WINONA-MONTGOMERY CONSOLIDATED SCHOOL DISTRICT IS AUTHORIZED AND EMPOWERED TO CONSTRUCT A HIGH SCHOOL FOR THE STUDENTS OF ITS DISTRICT ON ANY 5 PARCEL OF SIXTEENTH SECTION LAND WITHIN ITS CONTROL AND 6 JURISDICTION; TO PROVIDE THAT THE BOARD MAY RAISE FUNDS TO BUILD 7 THE HIGH SCHOOL FROM PRIVATE DONATIONS, BONDS OR ANY OTHER ALLOWABLE METHOD AS PROVIDED FOR IN LAW; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 37-7-104.4, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 10 amended as follows: 11 12 37-7-104.4. (1) In Montgomery County, Mississippi, in which are located, as of January 1, 2016, two (2) school districts, 13 14 there shall be an administrative consolidation of all of those school districts in the county into one (1) new countywide 15 16 municipal separate school district to be designated as Winona-Montgomery Consolidated School District which shall consist 17 of the territory of the former Montgomery County School District 18 19 and the Winona Municipal Separate School District, effective on 20 July 1, 2018. At such time that the administrative consolidation becomes effective, the central administrative office of the 21

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- 22 Winona-Montgomery Consolidated School District shall be located in
- 23 Winona, Mississippi.
- 24 (2) As soon as practicable, a financial advisor and/or other
- 25 facilitator with school district experience may be assigned by the
- 26 Mississippi Department of Education to oversee the budgeting and
- 27 financial matters relating to the consolidation of the districts
- 28 slated for consolidation. The financial advisor and/or
- 29 facilitator may, at the discretion of the Mississippi Department
- 30 of Education, continue duties for one (1) year after the
- 31 consolidation to ensure that all financial matters are in place.
- 32 All financial expenditures of districts that are closing must be
- 33 approved by the financial advisor and/or facilitator. If the
- 34 superintendent and/or school board approves expenditures outside
- 35 of this approval, they shall be personally liable for the excess
- 36 expenditures. The State Board of Education shall determine the
- 37 compensation to be paid to the financial advisor and/or
- 38 facilitator which shall be paid by the local school district to
- 39 which the financial advisor and/or facilitator is assigned.
- 40 (3) (a) On or before September 1, 2017, the State Board of
- 41 Education shall serve the local school board of the Winona
- 42 Municipal Separate School District and the local school board of
- 43 the Montgomery County School District with notice and instructions
- 44 regarding the timetable for action to be taken to comply with the
- 45 administrative consolidation required in this section.

4 6	(b) The members of the Winona-Montgomery Consolidated
47	School District Board of Trustees serving on July 1, 2020, shall
48	continue to serve until January 1, 2021, when the membership shall
49	be reconstituted as follows: On the first Tuesday after the first
50	Monday in November 2020, a special election shall be held in
51	Montgomery County for the purpose of electing a new board of
52	trustees of such district, which shall be elected from the
53	Supervisors Districts of Montgomery County. At said election the
54	member of the said board from District One shall be elected for a
55	term of one (1) year, the member from District Two shall be
56	elected for a term of two (2) years, the member from District
57	Three shall be elected for a term of three (3) years, the member
58	from District Four shall be elected for a term of four (4) years,
59	and the member from District Five shall be elected for a term of
60	five (5) years. Thereafter, members shall be elected at special
61	elections as vacancies occur for terms of five (5) years each.
62	All members shall reside in the supervisors district which the
63	member represents, and shall take office on the first Monday of
64	January following the date of their election. All trustees of
65	said school district shall otherwise be elected as provided for in
66	Sections 37-7-223 through 37-7-229, Mississippi Code of 1972. All
67	vacancies which may occur during a term shall be filled by
68	appointment of the consolidated school district trustees from the
69	qualified electors of the district in which the vacancy occurs.
70	However, the person so appointed shall serve only until the next

- 71 general election following such appointment, at which time a
- 72 person shall be elected for the remainder of the unexpired term at
- 73 the same time and in the same manner as a trustee is elected for
- 74 the full term then expiring and the person so elected to the
- 75 unexpired term shall take office immediately. Any school board
- 76 member of the former school districts residing in the proper
- 77 territory shall be eligible for appointment or election to the new
- 78 Board of Trustees for Winona-Montgomery Consolidated School
- 79 District.
- 80 (c) Any school district affected by the required
- 81 administrative consolidation in the county that does not
- 82 voluntarily consolidate as ordered by the State Board of Education
- 83 shall be administratively consolidated by the State Board of
- 84 Education, to be effective immediately upon action of the State
- 85 Board of Education. The State Board of Education shall promptly
- 86 move on its own motion to administratively consolidate a school
- 87 district which does not voluntarily consolidate in order to enable
- 88 the affected school districts to reasonably accomplish the
- 89 resulting administrative consolidation into one (1) consolidated
- 90 school district by July 1 following the motion to consolidate.
- 91 The affected school districts shall comply with any consolidation
- 92 order issued by the State Board of Education.
- 93 (4) (a) On July 1, 2018, following the motion of the State
- 94 Board of Education to consolidate school districts in Montgomery
- 95 County, the Montgomery County School District shall be abolished.

- 96 All real and personal property which is owned or titled in the
- 97 name of the school district located in such former school district
- 98 shall be transferred to the Winona-Montgomery Consolidated School
- 99 District as of July 1, 2018.
- 100 (b) The new board of trustees of the Winona-Montgomery
- 101 Consolidated School District shall be responsible for establishing
- 102 the contracts for operations, teachers, principals, clerical and
- 103 administrative staff personnel for the 2018-2019 school year and
- 104 each school year thereafter.
- 105 (c) The Superintendent of the Winona-Montgomery
- 106 Consolidated School District shall be appointed by the board and
- 107 is authorized to appoint an assistant superintendent, but in no
- 108 instance shall the administrative leadership of the
- 109 Winona-Montgomery Consolidated School District exceed three (3)
- 110 assistant superintendents to be appointed by the Superintendent of
- 111 the Winona-Montgomery Consolidated School District.
- 112 (d) It shall be the responsibility of the board of
- 113 trustees to prepare and approve the budget of the respective new
- 114 reorganized district, and the board of trustees may use staff from
- 115 the former school district to prepare the budget. Any transfer of
- 116 the assets, real or personal property of the Montgomery County
- 117 School District mandated by this section shall be final and
- 118 conclusive for the purposes of the transfer of property required
- 119 by this section to effectuate the administrative consolidation.

121	of the successor newly selected Board of Trustees of the
122	Winona-Montgomery Consolidated School District pursuant to the
123	required administrative consolidation may appeal therefrom within
124	ten (10) days from the date of the adjournment of the meeting at
125	which such order is entered. The appeal shall be taken in the
126	same manner as appeals are taken from judgments or decisions of
127	the board of supervisors as provided in Section 11-51-75, the
128	provisions of which shall be fully applicable to appeals taken
129	hereunder. The Board of Trustees of the Winona-Montgomery
130	Consolidated School District shall not pass upon or approve or
131	disapprove any such order until the time for an appeal therefrom

- 135 (5) Nothing in this section shall be construed to require 136 the closing of any school or school facility, unless the facility 137 is an unneeded administrative office located within a school 138 district which has been abolished under the provisions of this 139 section. All administrative consolidations under this section 140 shall be accomplished so as not to delay or in any manner 141 negatively affect the desegregation of another school district in 142 the county pursuant to court order.
- 143 (6) The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules and 144 regulations to facilitate the administrative consolidation of the

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- 145 school districts in Montgomery County pursuant to the requirements
- 146 of this section. Beginning with the insurance cafeteria plan year
- 147 of November 1, 2018, the consolidated districts shall fall under
- 148 all insurance plans and policies elected by the Winona-Montgomery
- 149 Consolidated School District, including the group term life
- insurance described in Section 25-15-9(7).
- 151 (7) The County Board of Education and the Superintendent of
- 152 Education of the former Montgomery County School District and the
- 153 local school board and Superintendent of Schools of the Winona
- 154 Municipal Separate School District shall cooperate with the State
- 155 Department of Education, as soon as practicable after July 1,
- 156 2016, for the planning and transition of programs, services and
- 157 alignment of curriculum for the administratively consolidated
- 158 school districts.
- 159 (8) It shall be the responsibility of the Board of
- 160 Supervisors of Montgomery County to provide office, furnishing and
- 161 utilities for the administrative Office of the Superintendent of
- 162 the Winona-Montgomery Consolidated School District.
- 163 (9) One (1) year prior to the date of consolidation, a
- 164 financial advisor and/or other facilitator with school district
- 165 experience may be assigned by the Mississippi Department of
- 166 Education to oversee the budgeting and financial matters relating
- 167 to the consolidation of the districts slated for consolidation.
- 168 The financial advisor and/or facilitator may, at the discretion of
- 169 the Mississippi Department of Education, continue duties for one

170	(1) year after the consolidation to ensure that all financial
171	matters are in place. All financial expenditures of districts
172	that are closing must be approved by the financial advisor and/or
173	facilitator. If the superintendent and/or school board approves
174	expenditures outside of this approval, they shall be personally
175	liable for the excess expenditures. The State Board of Education
176	shall determine the compensation to be paid to the financial
177	advisor and/or facilitator which shall be paid by the local school

- (10) The Board of Trustees of the Winona-Montgomery

 Consolidated School District is authorized and empowered to

 construct a high school for the students of its district on any

 parcel of sixteenth section land within its control and

 jurisdiction. The board may raise funds to build the high school

 from private donations, bonds or any other allowable method as

 provided for in law.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2022.
