1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-16-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT END-OF-COURSE ASSESSMENTS REQUIRED FOR HIGH SCHOOL 2 3 GRADUATION SHALL INCLUDE ONLY THOSE REQUIRED BY FEDERAL LAW; AND 4 FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 37-16-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 37-16-7. (1) Each district school board shall establish 8 9 standards for graduation from its schools which shall include as a 10 minimum: 11 (a) Mastery of minimum academic skills as measured by 12 assessments developed and administered by the State Board of 13 Education, provided that end-of-course assessments required for 14 graduation shall only include those that are required by federal 15 law. Completion of a minimum number of academic credits, 16 (b) 17 and all other applicable requirements prescribed by the district 18 school board.

High schools with graduation rates lower than eighty 21 percent (80%) must submit a detailed plan to the Mississippi 22 Department of Education to restructure the high school experience 23 to improve graduation rates.

(2) A student who meets all requirements prescribed in
subsection (1) of this section shall be awarded a standard diploma
in a form prescribed by the State Board of Education.
