SENATE BILL NO. 2794

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 5-1-41, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO  
2 PROVIDE THAT EACH SENATOR AND REPRESENTATIVE AND THE LIEUTENANT  
3 GOVERNOR SHALL RECEIVE THE STATUTORY OFFICE EXPENSE ALLOWANCE FOR  
4 EVERY MONTH OF HIS TERM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 5-1-41, Mississippi Code of 1972, is  
7 amended as follows:

8 5-1-41. Beginning with the 1986 Regular Session of the  
9 Legislature of the State of Mississippi, each Senator and  
10 Representative of the Legislature shall receive as compensation at  
11 each regular session the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00)  
12 and the mileage allowance provided by Section 25-3-41, for each  
13 mile of the distance by the most direct route usually traveled in  
14 coming to and returning from the place where the Legislature sits.  
15 Beginning on April 16, 1997, each Senator and Representative shall  
16 receive for attending each extraordinary session or called session  
17 the sum of Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00) per day and mileage at  
18 the same rate as per regular session. In addition to the above,  
19 beginning on \* \* \* July 1, 2022, each Senator and Representative



20 and the Lieutenant Governor shall receive the sum of One Thousand  
21 Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) per month for expenses incidental  
22 to his office for every \* \* \* month of his term \* \* \*; and  
23 payments shall be made to each Senator and Representative and the  
24 Lieutenant Governor by the State Treasurer between the first and  
25 tenth day of each month following the month for which the payments  
26 are due.

27       **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
28 and after July 1, 2022.
