SENATE BILL NO. 2826

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-1037, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REAPPORTION THE CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS OF MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR 3 RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 23-15-1037, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6 7 23-15-1037. (1) The State of Mississippi is hereby divided into * * * four (4) congressional districts below: 8 9 **FIRST DISTRICT.** - The First Congressional District shall be 10 composed of the following counties and portions of counties: 11 Alcorn, Benton, Calhoun, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Clay, DeSoto, Itawamba, Lafayette, Lee, Lowndes, Marshall, Monroe, Pontotoc, 12 Prentiss, Tate, Tippah, Tishomingo, Union, Webster * * *; * * * in 13 14 Winston County, the precincts of County Agent, *Shilioh and Zion 15 Ridge. **SECOND DISTRICT.** - The Second Congressional District shall 16 17 be composed of the following counties and portions of counties:

69 SECTION 2. Partial or split precincts are identified in this 70 act by an asterisk that precedes its designation within the 71 description of a district. The Chairman and Vice Chairman of the 72 Standing Joint Congressional Redistricting Committee shall file 73 with the Secretary of State the Split Precinct Block List 74 developed in conjunction with the plan contained in this act that 75 details the portions of the partial or split precincts that are 76 contained within a district by census block number, and such 77 document duly filed with the Secretary of State is hereby 78 incorporated into and shall be construed to be an integral part of 79 this act.

80 SECTION 3. This act shall be liberally construed to (1)81 effectuate the purposes thereof and to redistrict the 82 congressional districts of this state in compliance with 83 constitutional requirements. It is the intent of the Legislature that this act, and the districts described herein, completely 84 85 encompass all the area within the state. It is also intended that such districts contain all the inhabitants in this state. 86 It is 87 further intended that the redistricting provided for in this act 88 results in the creation of districts that are as close to equal in population as practicable. It is also intended that no district 89 90 shall contain any of the area included within the description of another district. 91

92 (2)If the districts described in this act do not carry out 93 the purposes thereof because of unintentional omissions, duplications, overlapping areas, erroneous nomenclature, lack of 94 adequate maps or descriptions of political subdivisions, wards or 95 other divisions thereof, or of their boundary lines, then the 96 97 Secretary of State, at the request of the Chair or Vice Chairman of the Standing Joint Congressional Redistricting Committee shall, 98 by order, correct such omissions, overlaps, erroneous nomenclature 99 100 or other defects in the description of districts so as to accomplish the purposes and objectives of this act. 101

102 (3) In promulgating such orders, the Secretary of State, in 103 addition to achieving equality in the population of districts and 104 ensuring that all areas of the state are completely and accurately 105 encompassed in such districts, shall be guided by the following 106 standards:

107 (a) In any instance in which there is a conflict 108 between the description of a district as provided in this act and 109 the map of the congressional districts developed by the Standing 110 Joint Congressional Redistricting Committee in conjunction with 111 the adopted redistricting plan, the map shall control; however, in 112 instances in which the map is inconclusive, the criteria provided in paragraphs (b) through (f) of this subsection shall control any 113 114 dispute or issue regarding the composition of any congressional 115 district;

(b) Gaps in the description of a district shall be completed in a manner that results in a total description of the district that is consonant with the description of adjacent districts and results in complete contiguity of districts;

(c) Areas of the state included within the descriptions of more than one (1) district shall be allocated to the district having the lowest population;

(d) Areas of the state not included within the descriptions of any district shall be allocated to the adjacent district having the lowest population;

(e) In the event that the area subject to corrected description or allocation as provided in paragraphs (b), (c) and (d) of this subsection is of such size or contains such population that its inclusion as a unit in any district would result in substantial disparity in the size, shape or population of the district, then the Secretary of State may allocate portions of the area to two (2) or more districts; and

(f) In any allocation of area or correction of descriptions made pursuant to this act, the Secretary of State shall, consistent with the foregoing standards, preserve the contiguity and compactness of districts and avoid the unnecessary division of political subdivisions.

(4) Copies of such orders shall be filed by the Secretary of
State in his office and in the offices of the affected
commissioners of election and registrars. The Secretary of State

Upon the 144 filing of an order, the description of any affected district shall 145 be deemed to have been corrected in the manner provided in such 146 order to the full extent as if the correction had been contained 147 in the original description provided in this act.

148 **SECTION 4.** The Standing Joint Congressional Redistricting 149 Committee is directed to provide all information necessary to 150 assist the counties in identifying the boundaries of the districts 151 described in this act.

152 SECTION 5. The redistricting contained in this act shall 153 supersede any prior redistricting, and any prior redistricting 154 shall be null and void upon the date this act is effectuated.

155 SECTION 6. If any paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or any 156 part of this act is declared to be unconstitutional or void, or if 157 for any reason is declared to be invalid or of no effect, the 158 remaining paragraphs, sentences, clauses, phrases or parts thereof 159 shall be in no manner affected thereby, but shall remain in full 160 force and effect.

161 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 162 and after its passage.
