## SENATE BILL NO. 2827

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3-3-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 REVISE THE LEGAL HOLIDAYS BY REMOVING CONFEDERATE MEMORIAL DAY AND 3 DESIGNATING THE NINETEENTH DAY OF JUNE AS JUNETEENTH FREEDOM DAY; 4 TO CLARIFY WHEN A LEGAL HOLIDAY WILL BE CELEBRATED IF THE HOLIDAY 5 FALLS ON A SATURDAY OR SUNDAY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 3-3-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows: 9 3-3-7. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2) 10 of this section, the following are declared to be legal holidays, 11 viz: 12 (a) The first day of January, designated as New Year's 13 Day; 14 (b) The third Monday of January, designated as both 15 Robert E. Lee's birthday and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s 16 birthday; 17 (c) The third Monday of February, designated as George 18 Washington's birthday; \* \* \* 19

No. 2827 G1/2 22/SS36/R14 PAGE 1 (jmr\kr) 20 The last Monday of May, designated as both National (d) 21 Memorial Day and Jefferson Davis' birthday; 22 (e) The nineteenth day of June, designated as 23 Juneteenth Freedom Day; 24 The fourth day of July, designated as Independence (f) 25 Day; 26 The first Monday of September, designated as Labor (g) 27 Day; 28 The eleventh day of November, designated as (h) 29 Armistice or Veterans' Day; 30 (i) The day fixed by proclamation by the Governor of Mississippi as a day of Thanksqiving, which shall be fixed to 31 32 correspond to the date proclaimed by the President of the United 33 States, designated as Thanksgiving Day; and 34 (j) The twenty-fifth day of December, designated as 35 Christmas Day. 36 \* \* \* If any legal holiday \* \* \* falls on a Saturday or Sunday, then the next following \* \* \* <u>Monday</u>, or another day 37 38 declared by proclamation of the Governor as the day to celebrate 39 the holiday, shall be a legal holiday. 40 (2) In lieu of any one (1) legal holiday provided for in subsection (1) of this section, with the exception of the third 41 42 Monday in January, designated as both Robert E. Lee's and Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday, and the eleventh day of November, 43 44 designated as Armistice or Veterans' Day, the governing

45 authorities of any municipality or county may declare, by order 46 spread upon its minutes, Mardi Gras Day or any one (1) other day 47 during the year, to be a legal holiday.

48 (3) August 16 is declared to be Elvis Aaron Presley Day in 49 recognition and appreciation of Elvis Aaron Presley's many 50 contributions, international recognition and the rich legacy left 51 to us by Elvis Aaron Presley. This day shall be a day of 52 recognition and observation and shall not be recognized as a legal 53 holiday.

54 May 8 is declared to be Hernando de Soto Day in (4) 55 recognition, observation and commemoration of Hernando de Soto, 56 who led the first and most imposing expedition ever made by 57 Europeans into the wilds of North America and the State of 58 Mississippi, and in further recognition of the Spanish explorer's 59 187-day journey from the Tombigbee River basin on our state's 60 eastern boundary, westward to the place of discovery of the 61 Mississippi River on May 8, 1541. This day shall be a day of commemoration, recognition and observation of Hernando de Soto and 62 63 European exploration and shall not be recognized as a legal 64 holiday.

(5) Armistice Day <u>or</u> Veterans' Day shall be observed by appropriate exercises in all the public schools in the State of Mississippi. The superintendent of schools of each public school district is authorized to provide for the appearance of uniformed military personnel, uniformed veterans or the families of fallen

The superintendent of 71 72 schools is also authorized to permit the school band and its 73 director(s) at any public school in the district to perform at Armistice or Veterans' Day exercises in the school district upon 74 the request of public officials or veterans associations without 75 76 loss of any program credit by participating students and without 77 loss of leave by participating school personnel.

78 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 79 and after its passage.
