AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-17-17, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 2 TO DELETE THE DUTY OF THE CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO 3 REPORT TO THE GRAND JURY THE RESULTS OF THE AUDIT REQUIRED BY THIS 4 SECTION; TO DELETE THE CRIMINAL PENALTY AGAINST THE CLERK OF THE 5 BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR FAILING TO REPORT TO THE GRAND JURY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 SECTION 1. Section 19-17-17, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 9

10 19-17-17. The clerk of the board of supervisors, as county 11 auditor, is authorized and required to examine the accounts, 12 dockets and records of clerks, sheriffs and other officers of his 13 county, to ascertain if any money payable into the county treasury is properly chargeable to them, and he shall charge them with such 14 15 money. * * *

16 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2022. 17
