SENATE BILL NO. 2917

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO EDWARD CARTER, SR., OF CLAIBORNE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Edward Carter, Sr., of Claiborne County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 conviction in 1998 of the crime of embezzlement in Claiborne
- 8 County, Mississippi, and who was sentenced to serve five (5) years
- 9 in the custody of the Department of Corrections with four (4)
- 10 years suspended and four (4) years on probation. He was released
- on April 9, 1999, on expiration of sentence and placed on
- 12 probation, and was discharged on April 11, 2003. The Legislature
- 13 is informed that he has since conducted himself as a law-abiding
- 14 and honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 15 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 16 and after its passage.
