SENATE BILL NO. 3010

1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI MEDICAL CENTER FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the University of Mississippi Medical
9	Center for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and ending
10	June 30, 2023 \$ 163,211,048.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
12	may be necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for
13	expenditure out of the proceeds derived from patient fees, student
14	fees or any other special source funds which are collected by or
15	otherwise become available, for the support and maintenance of the
16	University of Mississippi Medical Center for the fiscal year
17	beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023
18	\$ 1,638,541,808.00.

- 19 SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated and authorized for
- 20 expenditure under the provisions of Section 1 and Section 2, the
- University of Mississippi Medical Center shall maintain the School 21
- 22 of Medicine, the School of Dentistry, the School of Nursing, the
- School of Health Related Professions, the School of Population 23
- 24 Health, the Teaching Hospital and the Medical Center Service Area.
- The University of Mississippi Medical Center shall prepare and 25
- 26 make available to the Legislature an accounting of expenditures
- 27 for each of the divisions listed in this section at the beginning
- 28 of the legislative session.
- 29 SECTION 4. Due to critical nurse shortages and staffing, it
- 30 is the intention of the Legislature to enhance recognition of
- 31 excellence and expand the experience factor in attracting
- qualified registered nurses. 32
- 33 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, and the
- 34 funds authorized to be expended in Section 2, none may be used to
- 35 provide medical services on behalf of any state agency,
- institution or political subdivision, except to the extent that 36
- 37 such agency, institution or political subdivision reimburses the
- hospital for the cost of the services provided. Upon the 38
- 39 rendering of medical services to any such agency, institution or
- 40 political subdivision, the hospital shall issue an invoice for the
- 41 charges which shall be paid within ninety (90) days. In the event
- that payment is not made within ninety (90) days, the hospital 42
- shall discontinue providing services to that agency, institution 43

- 44 or political subdivision until all outstanding charges have been
- 45 paid.
- SECTION 6. Any funds appropriated pursuant to this act and
- 47 paid as a fee to or deposited in a financial institution shall be
- 48 in compliance with Section 109 of the Constitution of the State of
- 49 Mississippi and Section 25-4-105, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 50 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 51 University of Mississippi Medical Center's budget request for
- 52 Fiscal Year 2024 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative
- 53 Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the
- 54 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2023
- 55 budget request process.
- 56 **SECTION 8.** Of the funds authorized for expenditure in
- 57 Section 2, Six Million Eight Hundred Eighty-eight Thousand
- 58 Twenty-nine Dollars (\$6,888,029.00) shall be derived from the
- 59 Education Enhancement Fund from funds deposited pursuant to
- 60 Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 61 **SECTION 9.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 62 Section 2, Two Million Three Hundred Eighty Thousand Four Hundred
- 63 Thirty-one Dollars (\$2,380,431.00) shall be derived from the
- 64 Health Care Expendable Fund created in Section 43-13-407,
- 65 Mississippi Code of 1972, for the support and maintenance of the
- 66 University of Mississippi Medical Center.
- 67 **SECTION 10.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 68 of Section 1, the sum of Three Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars

- 69 (\$315,000.00) is hereby provided for scholarships for the Rural
- 70 Dentists Scholarship Program as described in House Bill 776, 2013
- 71 Regular Session.
- 72 It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 73 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 74 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 75 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 76 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 77 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 78 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 79 made without competitive bids.
- 80 SECTION 12. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and
- 81 Section 2, One Million Eight Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars
- (\$1,830,000.00) is hereby provided for scholarships for the Rural 82
- 83 Physicians' Scholarship Program as described in House Bill 1465,
- 2007 Regular Session. Of this amount, Thirty Thousand Dollars 84
- 85 (\$30,000.00) is provided for a Psychiatrist Scholarship as
- described in Senate Bill 2524, 2019 Regular Session. 86
- 87 SECTION 13. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- of Sections 1 and 2, Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars 88
- 89 (\$750,000.00) shall be derived from the State General Fund and
- 90 Four Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$4,250,000.00)
- 91 shall be derived from any special source funds collected by or
- otherwise become available for the support and maintenance of the 92

- 93 University of Mississippi Medical Center for the University of
- 94 Mississippi Medical Center Cancer Institute.
- 95 **SECTION 14.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Five
- 96 Hundred Ninety-five Thousand Dollars (\$595,000.00) is hereby
- 97 appropriated for A Comprehensive Tobacco (ACT) Center at the
- 98 University of Mississippi Medical Center.
- 99 **SECTION 15.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and
- 100 Section 2, One Million Three Hundred Eighty-two Thousand Two
- 101 Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,382,250.00) is provided for the Office
- 102 of Mississippi Physician Workforce as described in House Bill 317,
- 103 2012 Regular Session.
- 104 **SECTION 16.** None of the funds appropriated and/or authorized
- 105 for expenditure under this act shall be used for research that
- 106 kills or destroys an existing human embryo.
- 107 **SECTION 17.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 108 of Section 1, One Million Three Hundred Forty-nine Thousand Nine
- 109 Hundred Ninety-eight Dollars (\$1,349,998.00) shall be provided
- 110 from General Funds and shall be provided to the Center of
- 111 Excellence at the Blair E. Batson Hospital for Children for the
- 112 care of abused and neglected children, and expended to improve,
- 113 enlarge and/or construct the physical facilities of the Children's
- 114 Safe Center and for support and maintenance of the center.
- 115 **SECTION 18.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 116 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 117 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency

118	shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
119	appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
120	or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
121	actions contrary to this provision.
122	SECTION 19. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and
123	Section 2 of this act, Two Hundred Eighty Thousand Eight Hundred
124	Forty-eight Dollars (\$280,848.00) is provided for the
125	administration of the Rural Physicians' Scholarship Program and
126	the Rural Dentists' Scholarship Program.
127	SECTION 20. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
128	of Section 1, Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) shall be
129	provided to the MIND Center at the University of Mississippi
130	Medical Center.
131	SECTION 21. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
132	necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the Capital
133	Expense Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the University of
134	Mississippi Medical Center for the purpose of reauthorizing the
135	expenditure of Capital Expense Funds for the Asylum Hill Project,
136	as authorized in SB 2912, 2021 Regular Session, for the fiscal
137	year beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023
138	\$ 3,681,530.00.
139	Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the
140	provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended
141	exceed the unexpended balance of June 30, 2022.

142	SECTION 22. It is the intention of the Legislature that any
143	cash balances at the Office of Physician Workforce, the Children's
144	Safe Center, and the MIND Center shall only be spent in support of
145	those divisions.
146	SECTION 23. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
147	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
148	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
149	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
150	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
151	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
152	SECTION 24. This act shall take effect and be in force from
153	and after July 1, 2022, and shall stand repealed from and after
154	June 30, 2022.
