## SENATE BILL NO. 3010 (As Sent to Governor)

1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI MEDICAL CENTER FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the University of Mississippi Medical
9	Center for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and ending
10	June 30, 2023\$ 177,211,048.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
12	may be necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for
13	expenditure out of the proceeds derived from patient fees, student
14	fees or any other special source funds which are collected by or
15	otherwise become available, for the support and maintenance of the
16	University of Mississippi Medical Center for the fiscal year
17	beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023
18	\$ 1,757,267,199.00.

- 19 **SECTION 3.** With the funds appropriated and authorized for
- 20 expenditure under the provisions of Sections 1 and 2 of this act,
- 21 the University of Mississippi Medical Center shall maintain the
- 22 School of Medicine, the School of Dentistry, the School of
- 23 Nursing, the School of Health Related Professions, the School of
- 24 Population Health, the Teaching Hospital and the Medical Center
- 25 Service Area. The University of Mississippi Medical Center shall
- 26 prepare and make available to the Legislature an accounting of
- 27 expenditures for each of the divisions listed in this section at
- 28 the beginning of the legislative session.
- 29 **SECTION 4.** Due to critical nurse shortages and staffing, it
- 30 is the intention of the Legislature to enhance recognition of
- 31 excellence and expand the experience factor in attracting
- 32 qualified registered nurses.
- 33 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this
- 34 act, and the funds authorized to be expended in Section 2 of this
- 35 act, none may be used to provide medical services on behalf of any
- 36 state agency, institution or political subdivision, except to the
- 37 extent that such agency, institution or political subdivision
- 38 reimburses the hospital for the cost of the services provided.
- 39 Upon the rendering of medical services to any such agency,
- 40 institution or political subdivision, the hospital shall issue an
- 41 invoice for the charges which shall be paid within ninety (90)
- 42 days. In the event that payment is not made within ninety (90)
- 43 days, the hospital shall discontinue providing services to that

- 44 agency, institution or political subdivision until all outstanding
- 45 charges have been paid.
- 46 **SECTION 6.** Any funds appropriated pursuant to this act and
- 47 paid as a fee to or deposited in a financial institution shall be
- 48 in compliance with Section 109 of the Constitution of the State of
- 49 Mississippi and Section 25-4-105, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 50 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 51 University of Mississippi Medical Center's budget request for
- 52 Fiscal Year 2024 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative
- 53 Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the
- 54 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2023
- 55 budget request process.
- 56 **SECTION 8.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 of this
- 57 act, the following sums, or so much of those sums as may be
- 58 necessary, are derived out of any money in the State Treasury to
- 59 the credit of the Education Enhancement Fund pursuant to Sections
- 60 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, as follows:
- 61 (a) Education activities or scholarships \$ 6,888,029.00.
- 62 (b) Rural Physicians Scholarship Program \$ 340,000.00.
- 63 (c) Rural Dentists Scholarship Program \$ 105,000.00.
- 64 **SECTION 9.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 65 Section 2 of this act, Two Million Three Hundred Eighty Thousand
- 66 Four Hundred Thirty-one Dollars (\$2,380,431.00) shall be derived
- from the Health Care Expendable Fund created in Section 43-13-407,

- 68 Mississippi Code of 1972, for the support and maintenance of the
- 69 University of Mississippi Medical Center.
- 70 **SECTION 10.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 71 of Sections 1 and 2 of this act, the sum of Four Hundred Twenty
- 72 Thousand Dollars (\$420,000.00) is hereby provided for scholarships
- 73 for the Rural Dentists Scholarship Program as described in House
- 74 Bill 776, 2013 Regular Session.
- 75 **SECTION 11.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 76 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 77 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 78 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 79 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 80 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 81 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 82 made without competitive bids.
- 83 **SECTION 12.** Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2 of
- 84 this act, Two Million One Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars
- 85 (\$2,170,000.00) is hereby provided for scholarships for the Rural
- 86 Physicians Scholarship Program as described in House Bill 1465,
- 87 2007 Regular Session. Of this amount, Thirty-five Thousand
- 88 Dollars (\$35,000.00) is provided for a Psychiatrist Scholarship as
- 89 described in Senate Bill 2524, 2019 Regular Session.
- 90 **SECTION 13.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 91 of Sections 1 and 2 of this act, Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand
- 92 Dollars (\$750,000.00) shall be derived from the State General Fund

- 93 and Four Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars
- 94 (\$4,250,000.00) shall be derived from any special source funds
- 95 collected by or otherwise become available for the support and
- 96 maintenance of the University of Mississippi Medical Center for
- 97 the University of Mississippi Medical Center Cancer Institute.
- 98 **SECTION 14.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 of this
- 99 act, Five Hundred Ninety-five Thousand Dollars (\$595,000.00) is
- 100 hereby appropriated for A Comprehensive Tobacco (ACT) Center at
- 101 the University of Mississippi Medical Center.
- SECTION 15. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2 of
- 103 this act, One Million Three Hundred Eighty-two Thousand Two
- 104 Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,382,250.00) is provided for the Office
- 105 of Mississippi Physician Workforce as described in House Bill 317,
- 106 2012 Regular Session.
- 107 **SECTION 16.** None of the funds appropriated and/or authorized
- 108 for expenditure under this act shall be used for research that
- 109 kills or destroys an existing human embryo.
- 110 **SECTION 17.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 111 of Section 1 of this act, One Million Three Hundred Forty-nine
- 112 Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-eight Dollars (\$1,349,998.00) shall
- 113 be provided from General Funds and shall be provided to the Center
- 114 of Excellence at the Blair E. Batson Hospital for Children for the
- 115 care of abused and neglected children, and expended to improve,
- 116 enlarge and/or construct the physical facilities of the Children's
- 117 Safe Center and for support and maintenance of the center.

- 118 **SECTION 18.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 119 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 120 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 121 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 122 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- 123 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 124 actions contrary to this provision.
- 125 **SECTION 19.** Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2 of
- 126 this act, Two Hundred Eighty Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-eight
- 127 Dollars (\$280,848.00) is provided for the administration of the
- 128 Rural Physicians Scholarship Program and the Rural Dentists
- 129 Scholarship Program.
- 130 **SECTION 20.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 131 of Section 1 of this act, Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00)
- 132 shall be provided to the MIND Center at the University of
- 133 Mississippi Medical Center.
- 134 **SECTION 21.** It is the intention of the Legislature that any
- 135 cash balances at the Office of Physician Workforce, the Children's
- 136 Safe Center, and the MIND Center shall only be spent in support of
- 137 those divisions.
- 138 **SECTION 22.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this
- act, One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,200,000.00)
- 140 shall be provided for the Child Health and Developmental Promotion
- 141 (CHDP) Fellowship Program.

L42	<b>SECTION 23.</b> Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
L43	of Section 2 of this act, the following sum, or so much thereof as
L44	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
L45	State Treasury to the credit of the Coronavirus State Fiscal
L46	Recovery Lost Revenue Fund not otherwise appropriated to the
L47	credit of the University of Mississippi Medical Center\$ 55,000,000.
L48	These funds are provided for the purpose of constructing a
L49	new nursing school at the University of Mississippi Medical Center
L50	as allowable under Section 9901 of the American Rescue Plan Act of
L51	2021 (ARPA) or any guidance or regulation issued by the United
L52	States Department of the Treasury in conformity therewith.
L53	SECTION 24. (1) Of the funds appropriated under the
L54	provisions of Section 2 of this act, the following sum, or so much
L55	thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any
L56	money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Coronavirus State
L57	Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated to the credit of
L58	the University of Mississippi Medical Center\$ 50,000,000.00.
L59	These funds are provided for the purpose of completing
L60	capital improvements to the patient care facilities and operating
L61	suites of the Adult Hospital at the University of Mississippi
L62	Medical Center as allowable under Section 9901 of the American
L63	Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) or any guidance or regulation
L64	issued by the United States Department of the Treasury in
65	conformity therewith.

- 168 The agency shall not disburse any funds provided under this section to any recipient without first: (a) making an 169 170 individualized determination that the reimbursement sought is, in 171 the agency's independent judgment, for necessary expenditures eligible under Section 602 of the federal Social Security Act as 172 added by Section 9901 of the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 173 174 2021 (ARPA) and its implementing quidelines, quidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as may be amended or 175 supplemented from time to time, by the United States Department of 176 177 the Treasury; and (b) determining that the recipient has not 178 received and will not receive reimbursement for the expense in 179 question from any source of funds, including insurance proceeds, other than those funds provided under Section 602 of the federal 180 181 Social Security Act as added by Section 9901 of ARPA. 182 addition, the agency shall ensure that all funds provided under 183 this section are disbursed in compliance with the Single Audit Act 184 (31 USC Sections 7501-7507) and the related provisions of the 185 Uniform Guidance, 2 CFR Section 200.303 regarding internal 186 controls, Sections 200.330 through 200.332 regarding subrecipient 187 monitoring and management, and subpart F regarding audit 188 requirements.
- 189 (4) As a condition of receiving and expending the funds 190 provided to the agency under this section, the agency shall

certify to the Department of Finance and Administration that each expenditure of the funds provided to the agency under this section complies with the guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as may be amended from time to time, of the United States Department of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA.

If the Office of Inspector General of the United States Department of the Treasury, or the Office of Inspector General of any other federal agency having oversight over the use of monies from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA (a) determines that the agency or recipient has expended or otherwise used any of the funds provided to the agency under this section for any purpose that is not in compliance with the quidelines, quidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as may be amended from time to time, of the United States Department of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by the ARPA, and (b) the State of Mississippi is required to repay the federal government for any of those funds that the Office of the Inspector General determined were expended or otherwise used improperly by the agency or recipient, then the agency or recipient that expended or otherwise used those funds improperly shall be required to pay the amount of those funds to the State of Mississippi for repayment to the federal government.

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215	<b>SECTION 25.</b> The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
216	necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the Capital
217	Expense Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the University of
218	Mississippi Medical Center for the purpose of reauthorizing the
219	expenditure of Capital Expense Funds for the Asylum Hill Project,
220	as authorized in SB 2912, 2021 Regular Session, for the fiscal
221	year beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023
222	\$ 3,681,530.00.
223	Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the
224	provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended
225	exceed the unexpended balance of June 30, 2022.
226	SECTION 26. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
227	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
228	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
229	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
230	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
231	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
232	SECTION 27. This act shall take effect and be in force from
233	and after July 1, 2022.
