1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the administrative expenses of the Mississippi Community
9	College Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and
10	ending June 30, 2023\$ 6,116,874.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
13	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Community College Board,
14	for the purpose of defraying the administrative expenses of the
15	Mississippi Community College Board for the fiscal year beginning
16	July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023 149,179,989.00.
17	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 of this
18	act, Three Hundred Fifty-six Thousand Dollars (\$356,000.00) shall

19 be derived from the Education Enhancement Fund from	fund	ls

- 22 **SECTION 4.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 23 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
- 24 Treasury to the credit of the Commission on Proprietary School and
- 25 College Registration, for the purpose of defraying the expenses
- 26 incurred in the regulation and administration of the Mississippi
- 27 Proprietary School and College Registration Law and the associated
- 28 expenses of the Mississippi Community College Board for the fiscal
- 29 year beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023.....
- 30\$ 574,386.00.
- 31 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 32 this act, the following positions are authorized:
- 33 AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT:
- 34 Permanent: 52
- 35 Time-Limited: 0
- 36 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 37 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.
- 38 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 39 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 40 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 41 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 42 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 43 budget requests of the administrative expenses of the Mississippi

- 44 Community College Board for Fiscal Year 2024 shall be submitted to
- 45 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 46 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 47 during the Fiscal Year 2023 budget request process.
- 48 **SECTION 7.** Of the funds appropriated herein, up to One
- 49 Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be expended from the Work
- 50 Force Carryover Fund as created by House Bill No. 1271, 1995
- 51 Regular Session.
- 52 **SECTION 8.** Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2 of
- 53 this act, funds in the amount of Fifty Million Eight Hundred
- 54 Thirty-one Thousand Eight Hundred Two Dollars (\$50,831,802.00) are
- 55 appropriated for the Workforce Education Program and Industrial
- 56 Training. No funding obligation or commitment shall be made on
- 57 behalf of the state for industrial training beyond the level of
- 58 funding made available in this section. All industrial training
- 59 program commitments made in Fiscal Year 2023 and future fiscal
- 60 years shall be based only upon funds available in this section and
- 61 any proposed commitments shall be approved by the Executive
- 62 Director of the Mississippi Community College Board, or the
- 63 Executive Director's designee prior to such commitment being
- 64 finalized. Industrial training program commitments shall be made
- 65 and based only upon training services provided and not for a
- 66 specific funding amount. Any expenditures of funds authorized in
- 67 this section are limited to obligations made July 1, 2022, or

- 68 after, and shall not be expended for obligations made prior to
- 69 this date.
- 70 **SECTION 9.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 of this
- 71 act, funds in the amount of Thirty Million Dollars
- 72 (\$30,000,000.00) shall be derived from unemployment compensation
- 73 contributions deposited into the Mississippi Workforce Enhancement
- 74 Training Fund and shall be utilized exclusively by the Mississippi
- 75 Community College Board for workforce training in accordance with
- 76 Senate Bill No. 2027, 2010 Regular Session. It is the intention
- 77 of the Legislature that the Workforce Enhancement Training Fund
- 78 shall have not less than Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) set
- 79 aside as a carry-forward to begin the Fiscal Year 2024 Workforce
- 80 Education Program.
- 81 **SECTION 10.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 of this
- 82 act, funds in the amount of Two Million Five Hundred Thousand
- 83 Dollars (\$2,500,000.00) shall be derived from fees charged for the
- 84 Workforce Online Training Program, and the Mississippi Virtual
- 85 Community College and funds in the amount of Two Million One
- 86 Hundred Forty-four Thousand Nine Hundred Fourteen Dollars
- 87 (\$2,144,914.00) shall be transferred from the Community and Junior
- 88 College Education Technology Fund for the purpose of defraying the
- 89 costs of the Mississippi Virtual Community College, the Workforce
- 90 Online Training Program and the administrative expenses of the
- 91 Mississippi Community College Board.

- 92 **SECTION 11.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 93 of Section 2 of this act, funds in the amount of One Hundred
- 94 Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) shall be derived from
- 95 fees charged for issuing duplicate transcripts and duplicate
- 96 diplomas for the High School Equivalency Testing Program for the
- 97 purpose of defraying the costs of administering the High School
- 98 Equivalency Testing Program of the Mississippi Community College
- 99 Board, in accordance with Senate Bill No. 2626, 2002 Regular
- 100 Session.
- 101 **SECTION 12.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 of this
- 102 act, funds in the amount of Thirty Million Dollars
- 103 (\$30,000,000.00) shall be derived from the transfer of
- 104 postsecondary vocational and technical funds from the Mississippi
- 105 Department of Education to the Mississippi Community College Board
- 106 for the purpose of managing the day-to-day operations of
- 107 postsecondary career and technical education.
- 108 **SECTION 13.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this
- 109 act, Five Hundred Forty-two Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-nine
- 110 Dollars (\$542,459.00) is provided to the Mississippi Community
- 111 College Board for the purpose of defraying the cost of the
- 112 Greenville Higher Education Center.
- 113 **SECTION 14.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 114 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 115 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 116 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,

- 117 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 118 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 119 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 120 made without competitive bids.
- 121 **SECTION 15.** It is the intention of the Legislature that an
- 122 amount equal to One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) per square foot
- 123 shall be transferred to the Executive Office of the Board of
- 124 Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning to defray
- 125 utility costs.
- 126 **SECTION 16.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this
- 127 act, Thirty-seven Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-six Dollars
- 128 (\$37,626.00) is provided for geospatial site licenses.
- 129 **SECTION 17.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 130 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 131 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 132 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 133 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- 134 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 135 actions contrary to this provision.
- 136 **SECTION 18.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 of this
- 137 act, Thirty Million Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars
- 138 (\$30,700,000.00), or so much as may be necessary, shall be derived
- 139 out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the
- 140 Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75
- and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, and shall be expended by

158	SECTION 19. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 of this
159	act, Twenty-two Million Dollars (\$22,000,000.00), or so much as
160	may be necessary, shall be derived out of any money in the State
161	Treasury to the credit of the Education Enhancement Fund deposited
162	pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of
163	1972, for the following purposes:
164	Hinds Community College Nursing School\$ 8,000,000.00.
165	Jones Community College Nursing School\$ 2,000,000.00.
166	Holmes Community College Nursing School\$ 6,000,000.00.

167	Northwest Community College dormitory\$ 6,000,000.00
168	SECTION 20. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
169	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
170	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
171	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
172	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
173	proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
174	SECTION 21. This act shall take effect and be in force from
175	and after July 1, 2022.
