3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:			
4	SECTION 1. The	e following sum, or so	much thereof as may be	
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State			
6	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Dental			
7	Examiners, for the support of said board for the fiscal year			
8	beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023

10	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of			
11	this act, the following positions are authorized:

17	With the funds	herein appropriated, i	t shall be the agency's	
18	responsibility to make certain that funds required for "Personal			
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19 Services" for Fiscal Year 2024 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2023 20 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2023 budget by the 21 22 Mississippi Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the 23 agency's personal services appropriation, which shall be published 24 by the State Personnel Board. Additionally, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annualized payroll 25 26 costs based on current employees. It shall be the responsibility 27 of the agency head to ensure that actual personnel expenditures for Fiscal Year 2023 do not exceed the data provided by the 28 29 Legislative Budget Office. If the agency's Fiscal Year 2023 30 projected cost exceeds the annualized costs, no salary actions 31 shall be processed by the State Personnel Board with the exception 32 of new hires that are determined to be essential for the agency.

33 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 34 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 35 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 36 37 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 38 39 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 40 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 41 appropriated level.

42 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 43 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are

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None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

Funds have been appropriated herein for the purpose of funding Project SEC2 minimum salaries for all employees covered under the Colonel Guy Groff/Neville Kenning Variable Compensation Plan. It shall be the agency's responsibility to ensure that the funds are used to increase all employees' salaries up to the minimum level as determined by the State Personnel Board.

56 SECTION 3. Of the funds provided under the provisions of 57 this act, an amount not to exceed Twenty-seven Thousand Dollars 58 (\$27,000.00) shall be allocated to the Mississippi Board of 59 Pharmacy to defray the expenses of the Mississippi Prescription 60 Monitoring Program.

61 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 62 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 63 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 64 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 65 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 66 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 67 actions contrary to this provision.

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68 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that 69 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 70 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 71 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 72 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 73 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 74 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 75 made without competitive bids.

76 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 77 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 78 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 79 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 80 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 81 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 82 and after July 1, 2022, and shall stand repealed from and after 83

84 June 30, 2022.
