12	SECTION 2. Of	the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, the following positions are authorized:

- 19 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 20 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 21 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 22 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 23 None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 24 violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating
- to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as 25
- 26 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- 27 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 28 Mississippi State Board of Examiners for Licensed Professional
- 29 Counselors shall maintain complete accounting and personnel
- 30 records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under
- 31 this act and that such records shall be in the same format and
- 32 level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2022. It is further
- 33 the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request
- 34 for Fiscal Year 2024 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative
- 35 Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the
- 36 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2023
- 37 budget request process.
- 38 It is the intention of the Legislature that SECTION 4.
- 39 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 40 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 41 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 42
- shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 43

- 44 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 45 made without competitive bids.
- 46 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 47 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 48 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 49 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 50 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 52 actions contrary to this provision.
- 53 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 54 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 55 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 56 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 57 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 58 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 59 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 60 and after July 1, 2022, and shall stand repealed from and after
- 61 June 30, 2022.
