The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 9 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the 10 Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, 11 to the Department of Environmental Quality for the purpose of administering the Mississippi Municipality and County Water 12 13 Infrastructure (MCWI) Grant Program established in Senate Bill No. 2822, 2022 Regular Session, for the period beginning upon passage 14 of this act and ending June 30, 2023.....\$ 450,000,000.00. 15 16 SECTION 2. None of the funds appropriated under this act 17 shall be used to pay employee premium payments. 18 SECTION 3. (1) As used in this section and Section 4 of this act, the term "department" means the Department of 19

Environmental Quality.

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- 21 The department shall not disburse any funds appropriated 22 under this act to any recipient without first: (a) making an 23 individualized determination that the reimbursement sought is, in the department's independent judgment, for necessary expenditures 24 25 eligible under Section 602 of the federal Social Security Act as 26 added by Section 9901 of the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 27 2021 (ARPA) and its implementing quidelines, quidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as may be amended or 28 29 supplemented from time to time, by the United States Department of 30 the Treasury; and (b) determining that the recipient has not 31 received and will not receive reimbursement for the expense in question from any source of funds, including insurance proceeds, 32 33 other than those funds provided under Section 602 of the federal Social Security Act as added by Section 9901 of ARPA. 34 addition, the department shall ensure that all funds appropriated 35 36 under this act are disbursed in compliance with the Single Audit 37 Act (31 USC Sections 7501-7507) and the related provisions of the Uniform Guidance, 2 CFR Section 200.303 regarding internal 38 39 controls, Sections 200.330 through 200.332 regarding subrecipient 40 monitoring and management, and subpart F regarding audit
- SECTION 4. (1) As a condition of receiving and expending
 the funds appropriated to the department under this act, the
 department shall certify to the Department of Finance and
 Administration that each expenditure of the funds appropriated to

- 68 expended or otherwise used those funds improperly shall be
- 69 required to pay the amount of those funds to the State of
- 70 Mississippi for repayment to the federal government.

71	SECTION 5. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
72	by the State Treasurer out of any money in the Coronavirus State
73	Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants
74	issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer
75	shall issue his or her warrants upon requisitions signed by the
76	proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
77	SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
78	and after its passage.
