SENATE BILL NO. 3061

AN ACT MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION FROM THE 1 2 CORONAVIRUS STATE FISCAL RECOVERY FUND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC 3 SAFETY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING DEATH BENEFITS TO THE BENEFICIARIES OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AND FIREFIGHTERS THAT 4 5 HAVE DIED IN THE LINE OF DUTY DUE TO THE CORONAVIRUS. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the 8 9 Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, 10 to the Department of Public Safety for the purpose described in this section, for the period beginning July 1, 2021, and ending 11 12 June 30, 2022.....\$ 7,500,000.00. 13 This additional appropriation is for the purpose of paying one-time death benefit payment of One Hundred Thousand Dollars 14 15 (\$100,000.00) in the same manner that the department provides benefits under Section 45-2-1. This death benefit shall be paid 16 17 to the beneficiaries of law enforcement officers or firefighters, including volunteer firefighters, when employed by an employer; it 18 19 does not include employees of independent contractors.

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20 SECTION 2. Whenever used in this act, the following terms 21 beneficiary, law enforcement officer, firefighter, and employer 22 shall be defined as the same term set out in Section 45-2-1. 23 SECTION 3. (1) As used in this section and Section 4 of

24 this act, the term "department" means the Department of Public 25 Safety.

The department shall not disburse any funds appropriated 26 (2)27 under this act to any recipient without first: (a) making an 28 individualized determination that the reimbursement sought is, in 29 the department's independent judgment, for necessary expenditures 30 eligible under Section 602 of the federal Social Security Act as added by Section 9901 of the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 31 32 2021 (ARPA) and its implementing guidelines, guidance, rules, 33 regulations and/or other criteria, as may be amended or 34 supplemented from time to time, by the United States Department of 35 the Treasury; and (b) determining that the recipient has not received and will not receive reimbursement for the expense in 36 37 question from any source of funds, including insurance proceeds, other than those funds provided under Section 602 of the federal 38 Social Security Act as added by Section 9901 of ARPA. 39 In 40 addition, the department shall ensure that all funds appropriated 41 under this act are disbursed in compliance with the Single Audit Act (31 USC Sections 7501-7507) and the related provisions of the 42 Uniform Guidance, 2 CFR Section 200.303 regarding internal 43 44 controls, Sections 200.330 through 200.332 regarding sub-recipient

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45 monitoring and management, and subpart F regarding audit 46 requirements.

47 As a condition of receiving and expending SECTION 4. (1)the funds appropriated to the department under this act, the 48 49 department shall certify to the Department of Finance and 50 Administration that each expenditure of the funds appropriated to the department under this act complies with the quidelines, 51 guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as may be 52 53 amended from time to time, of the United States Department of the 54 Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus State 55 Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA.

56 (2)If the Office of Inspector General of the United States Department of the Treasury, or the Office of Inspector General of 57 any other federal agency having oversight over the use of monies 58 59 from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by 60 ARPA (a) determines that the department or recipient has expended or otherwise used any of the funds appropriated to the department 61 62 under this act for any purpose that is not in compliance with the guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as 63 may be amended from time to time, of the United States Department 64 65 of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by the ARPA, and (b) the 66 67 State of Mississippi is required to repay the federal government for any of those funds that the Office of the Inspector General 68 69 determined were expended or otherwise used improperly by the

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70 department or recipient, then the department or recipient that 71 expended or otherwise used those funds improperly shall be 72 required to pay the amount of those funds to the State of 73 Mississippi for repayment to the federal government.

74 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 75 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 76 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 77 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer, and the State Fiscal 78 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 79 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 80 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. 81
