SENATE BILL NO. 3069

1 AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 919, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 2020, TO ADD CARE NOW FOOD PANTRY AS A 501(C) (3) QUALIFIED CHARITABLE 2 3 ORGANIZATION TO WHICH THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARSHALL COUNTY, 4 MISSISSIPPI, MAY CONTRIBUTE ANNUALLY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 919, Local and Private Laws of 2020, is 6 7 amended as follows: Section 1. The Board of Supervisors of Marshall County, 8 9 Mississippi, in its discretion, is authorized to contribute 10 annually, in an aggregate amount not to exceed Seven Thousand Five 11 Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00), to qualified charitable organizations 12 with valid and current 501(c)(3) designations, for the support of food pantries operated by the organizations. The organizations to 13 14 which the board may contribute are North Mississippi Research Training and Development, Inc., Food Pantry, Hearts and Hands 15 Food Pantry, Hearn Grove Church Food Pantry, Mt. Zion Church Food 16 17 Pantry, Care Now Food Pantry, and Davis Temple Church of the Living God Food Pantry. 18

Section 2. This act shall be repealed from and after October 1, 2023.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 22 and after its passage.
