SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 510

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE  
2 MISSISSIPPI "BRAVES" BASEBALL TEAM THE AA AFFILIATE OF THE WORLD  
3 CHAMPIONSHIP ATLANTA BRAVES AND MANAGER DAN MEYER FOR WINNING THE  
4 DOUBLE-A SOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES AT TRUSTMARK PARK IN PEARL,  
5 MISSISSIPPI, THEIR FIRST LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP SINCE 2008.

6 WHEREAS, Trustmark Park is, once again, the home of  
7 champions; and

8 WHEREAS, Pitchers Alan Rangel, Brandon White, Jake  
9 Higginbotham and Nolan Kingham combined to retire 20 straight  
10 batters, and the Mississippi Braves defeated the Montgomery  
11 Biscuits 2-1 on September 26, 2021, in the deciding Game 5 of the  
12 Double-A South Championship Series; and

13 WHEREAS, the Mississippi Braves claimed their second League  
14 Championship since moving to Pearl 16 years ago, adding the 2021  
15 Double-A South trophy to the 2008 Southern League trophy; and

16 WHEREAS, the Mississippi Braves recorded the best winning  
17 percentage in club history (.604) by finishing 67-44 during the  
18 regular season. They won the regular season Double-A South  
19 Championship by 8 games over the Biscuits, and then went the limit



20 with them in the Championship Series. Montgomery won Game 4,  
21 14-2, to force the winner-take-all matchup at Trustmark Park. The  
22 Mississippi Braves' pitching staff made just enough offense stand  
23 up; and

24 WHEREAS, in the sixth inning, Greyson Jenista hit a solo home  
25 run for what turned out to be the game-winning run. The home run  
26 was Jenista's third of the Championship Series and 22nd of the  
27 season. Overall, the Mississippi Braves hit seven home runs  
28 during the five-game series. The 24-year-old Rangel turned in a  
29 brilliant start, allowing one run and striking out eight players  
30 through six innings. It was his first postseason start and first  
31 outing in 11 days; and
