SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 524

- A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING CONGRESS TO PROPOSE AND SUBMIT TO THE STATES FOR RATIFICATION AN AMENDMENT TO THE UNITED STATES
- 3 CONSTITUTION PROVIDING THAT AN INCREASE IN THE FEDERAL DEBT
- 4 REQUIRES APPROVAL FROM A MAJORITY OF LEGISLATURES OF THE SEPARATE
- 5 STATES.
- 6 WHEREAS, the United States has operated on a budget deficit,
- 7 including the 2021 budget year, which surpassed an astounding
- 8 \$2.77 trillion, the second highest on record; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the higher the deficit, the more the government must
- 10 spend on paying interest on the debt; compounding the problem is
- 11 the use of deficit spending, which becomes a responsibility for
- 12 future generations of Americans to assume without their consent;
- 13 and
- 14 WHEREAS, further compounding the problem is that Congress has
- 15 wholly abandoned the regular budgeting and appropriation process,
- 16 and has resorted to reconciliation in lieu of full debate and
- 17 discussion; and
- 18 WHEREAS, this growing burden of public debt is a threat to
- 19 the nation's economic health, and action must be taken to restore

- 20 fiscal responsibility; a federal debt limitation would compel
- 21 lawmakers to carefully consider choices about spending and taxes:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 23 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
- 24 we do hereby respectfully urge the Congress of the United States
- 25 to propose and submit to the states for ratification an amendment
- 26 to the United States Constitution providing that an increase in
- 27 the federal debt requires approval from a majority of the
- 28 Legislatures of the separate states.
- 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be
- 30 transmitted by the Secretary of State, to the President of the
- 31 United States Senate, to the Speaker of the United States House of
- 32 Representatives, and to each member of the Mississippi
- 33 congressional delegation.
