- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
- 6 MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi
- 7 Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the
- 8 state:
- 9 Amend Section 33, Mississippi Constitution of 1890, to read
- 10 as follows:
- 11 Section 33. (1) The legislative power of this state shall
- 12 be vested in a Legislature which shall consist of a Senate and a
- 13 House of Representatives.
- 14 (2) The Legislature by general law may provide for a citizen
- 15 initiative procedure for proposing amendments to the general laws
- 16 of Mississippi.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this proposed amendment shall be
- 18 submitted by the Secretary of State to the qualified electors at
- 19 an election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday

20	of	November	2023,	as	provided	bу	Section	273	of	the	Constitution

- 21 and by general law.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this proposed
- 23 amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed
- 24 amendment authorizes the Legislature to enact legislation
- 25 establishing a citizen initiative procedure for proposing
- 26 amendments to the general laws of Mississippi."
