SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 572

- 1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE 2 BIGGERSVILLE HIGH SCHOOL "LIONS" GIRLS AND BOYS BASKETBALL TEAMS 3 AND HEAD COACH CLIFF LITTLE FOR WINNING TWO MHSAA CLASS 1A STATE
- CHAMPIONSHIPS ON THE SAME DAY.
- WHEREAS, on Thursday, March 3, 2022, Biggersville High School 5
- "Lady Lions" claimed the Mississippi High School Activities 6
- 7 Association (MHSAA) Class 1A Girls Basketball State Title 56-53
- over McEvans. Asia Stafford was named "Player of the Game"; and 8
- 9 WHEREAS, Coach Cliff Little then led the Biggersville Boys to
- 10 a 45-37 State Title win over H.W. Byers at the Mississippi
- 11 Coliseum; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Coach Cliff Little is now on the list of coaches who
- 13 have a Mississippi High School Girls Basketball State Championship
- 14 and a Mississippi Boys Basketball State Championship. It's the
- second title in as many years for Coach Little, who led the 15
- Biggersville Boys to their first title since 2013 last year. It's 16
- 17 his first title in girls basketball. It's the fifth state title
- 18 for Coach Little, who now has three as Biggersville's Boys Coach,

- 19 one as East Webster's Boys Coach, and one as Biggersville's Girls
- 20 Coach; and
- 21 WHEREAS, "With our girls, there's more to basketball than
- 22 just Xs and Os," Coach Little said. "There's character, and these
- 23 girls had no quit in them all year." McEvans led by as much as 11
- 24 in the third quarter, but the Lions cut the deficit to one by the
- 25 end of the quarter and kept the momentum going in the fourth; and
- 26 WHEREAS, following the win, Coach Little turned his attention
- 27 to coach the boys team in its Class 1A State Title Game against
- 28 H.W. Byers. "Luckily, they pretty much coach themselves," Coach
- 29 Little said of the boys team. "I've got a group of seniors who
- 30 are unbelievable. Win or lose, it's the best team I've ever had";

- 46 basketball tradition in these student athletes who again have
- 47 brought honor to their school, their community and to the State of
- 48 Mississippi:
