SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 575

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE  
2 CLINTON HIGH SCHOOL "ARROWS" BOYS BASKETBALL TEAM AND COACH  
3 LEONARD TAYLOR FOR WINNING BACK-TO-BACK MHSAA CLASS 6A STATE  
4 CHAMPIONSHIPS.

5 WHEREAS, Clinton High School "Arrows" Boys Basketball Coach  
6 Leonard Taylor was calm with Jaylon Davis at the free-throw line.  
7 Less than 10 seconds remained in the fourth quarter of the  
8 Mississippi High School Activities Association (MHSAA) Class 6A  
9 Championship Game and Clinton trailed Olive Branch by one; and

10 WHEREAS, Senior Jaylon Davis knocked both down and gave the  
11 Arrows their first lead of the game. Clinton (23-5) held on to  
12 win 76-75 over Olive Branch (28-5) on March 5, 2022, at the  
13 Mississippi Coliseum and secured back-to-back MHSAA Class 6A State  
14 Championships; and

15 WHEREAS, Clinton winning its third State Title in program  
16 history looked improbable early, when the Olive Branch  
17 Conquistadors jumped out to a 21-8 lead in the first quarter and  
18 extended their lead to 17 points with 30 seconds remaining in the  
19 third quarter. Clinton would need another comeback, after erasing



20 a double-digit second-half lead against Brandon in the Semifinals,  
21 for the victory; and

22 WHEREAS, Kimani Hamilton helped lead the charge. The senior  
23 had a game-high 24 points, nine rebounds and two blocks. Hughes  
24 finished with 18 points, six rebounds and three assists. Hamilton  
25 scored six of his points in the final three minutes. The  
26 three-star forward had back-to-back drives into the lane to cut  
27 the Olive Branch lead to one point. With 30.4 seconds remaining,  
28 Hamilton's finish through contact gave Clinton new life, and Davis  
29 finished it off at the free-throw line. Davis finished with 12  
30 points and six rebounds, including a layup to extend a 19-10 start  
31 to the fourth quarter for Clinton; and

32 WHEREAS, Clinton was ranked No. 2 in the *Clarion Ledger*  
33 "Super 10" Final High School Boys Basketball Rankings; and

34 WHEREAS, "I'm so proud of them," Coach Taylor said. "They  
35 know how to fight. We try to tell them there's no 13-point  
36 basket. One play at a time. Get a basket after a basket and get  
37 a defensive stop. We'll get right back where we need to be"; and

38 WHEREAS, the 2021-2022 Clinton High School "Arrows" Boys  
39 Basketball Team Championship Roster is: Ashten Michael-Neal,
