SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 586

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION DESIGNATING APRIL 14, 2022, AS "REMAN 2 DAY" IN MISSISSIPPI. 3 WHEREAS, remanufacturing is a comprehensive and rigorous industrial process by which a previously sold, leased, used, worn, 4 5 remanufactured or nonfunctional product or part is returned to a 6 like-new, same-as-when-new, or better-than-when-new condition, 7 from both a quality and performance perspective, through a 8 controlled, reproducible and sustainable process; and 9 WHEREAS, a 2012 United States International Trade Commission (ITC) report found that remanufacturers support at least 180,000 10 11 full-time jobs in the United States. Further, the ITC report 12 states that production of remanufactured goods in the United 13 States increased by 15 percent from 2009 to 2011 and exports totaled \$11.2 Billion annually; and 14 WHEREAS, remanufacturing has been recognized by leading 15 16 universities, research institutions and manufacturers in the 17 United States as good for the environment for its ability to 18 divert end-of-life products from landfills; and N1/2 S.
