## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 589

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE 2 SUMMER FIELD PROGRAM AT THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN MISSISSIPPI'S 3 GULF COAST RESEARCH LABORATORY ON THE OCCASION OF ITS 75TH 4 ANNIVERSARY AND RECOGNIZING ITS ACHIEVEMENTS.

5 WHEREAS, the inaugural class of the Gulf Coast Research 6 Laboratory's (GCRL) Summer Field Program (SFP) was sponsored by 7 the Mississippi Academy of Sciences in 1947 and held at the 8 Magnolia State Park in Ocean Springs; and

9 WHEREAS, the activities of the Summer Field Program and 10 associated needs for coastal research and teaching in Mississippi 11 led to the creation of the Gulf Coast Research Laboratory in 1950; 12 and

WHEREAS, the Summer Field Program initially consisted of two 13 14 classes of students and has now grown to include 63 college and university affiliates from 19 states; and 15

24 WHEREAS, the Summer Field Program continues to be a core 25 program supporting Gulf Coast Research Laboratory's mission of 26 advancing scientific discovery and promoting academic growth in 27 the fields of marine biology and coastal sciences for the 28 betterment of society, the wise use of natural resources, and the 29 advancement of sound economic development:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That we do hereby commend and congratulate the Summer Field Program at The University of Southern Mississippi's Gulf Coast Research Laboratory on the occasion of its 75th Anniversary and recognize its achievements.
