SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 594

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE
2 BOONEVILLE HIGH SCHOOL "LADY BLUE DEVILS" GIRLS BASKETBALL TEAM
3 AND HEAD COACH MICHAEL SMITH FOR WINNING THE 2022 MHSAA CLASS 3A
4 GIRLS BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP, THEIR THIRD STATE TITLE IN SCHOOL
5 HISTORY.

6 WHEREAS, in 2022, the Hill Country has had an incredible
7 showing at the Mississippi High School Activities Association
8 (MHSAA) Basketball Championships at the Mississippi Coliseum, and
9 the Girls 3A Championship was no exception; and

10 WHEREAS, the Booneville Blue Devils created separation with a
11 big second quarter and played four quarters of strong defense to
12 hold off Noxubee County 46-30 to claim the MHSAA Girls Class 3A
13 State Championship; and

14 WHEREAS, it is Booneville's (29-2) third State Title in their
15 school's history and first State Title since 2016; and

16 WHEREAS, "The game was very emotional, a lot of ups and
17 downs, and the girls fought through it and got it done. Our girls
18 gave them a big punch in the second quarter and again in the
19 fourth quarter," said Booneville Head Coach Michael Smith; and



20 WHEREAS, Noxubee County held a 10-9 lead in the first
21 quarter, but the second quarter was all Booneville. Noxubee
22 County cut the lead down to 11 points at 28-17 in the early part
23 of the third quarter, as the Lady Tigers went on a 6-1 run.
24 Booneville scored the first five points of the fourth quarter to
25 take a 42-25 lead to seal the game. Coach Smith cleared the bench
26 with more than two minutes to go; and

27 WHEREAS, the 2021-2022 Lady Blue Devil's Basketball Team

35 WHEREAS, Coach Michael Smith explained after Booneville's
36 45-30 win over Franklin County in the MHSAA 3A Semifinal at the
37 Mississippi Coliseum. "We're proud of where we are now compared
38 to where we were a year ago. We've come a long way." Make no
39 mistake, this is the same Booneville program that has played for
40 seven championships in the last 10 years. The championship
41 victory over Noxubee County made eight championships in 11 years;
