SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 595

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE  
2 BOONEVILLE HIGH SCHOOL "BLUE DEVILS" BASEBALL TEAM AND HEAD COACH  
3 KEVIN WILLIAMS FOR WINNING THE 2021 MHSAA CLASS 3A STATE  
4 CHAMPIONSHIP WHICH IS THE SECOND TITLE IN SCHOOL HISTORY.

5 WHEREAS, on June 5, 2021, behind a stellar offensive  
6 performance and relentless hitting, the Booneville High School  
7 "Blue Devils" Baseball Team raced past Magee 12-4 in the decisive  
8 Game Three to claim the Mississippi High School Activities  
9 Association (MHSAA) Class 3A State Championship at Trustmark Park  
10 in Pearl, Mississippi; and

11 WHEREAS, the victory was Booneville's second State Title in  
12 school history and first since 1999; and

13 WHEREAS, "We got a large group of seniors (12) and we've  
14 talked before about what it takes to win these types of games.  
15 This was four years of hard work finally coming together. These  
16 guys never had any doubt after the setback in Game One. We felt  
17 good coming into Game Three with the depth of our pitching," said  
18 Booneville Head Coach Kevin Williams; and

19 WHEREAS, the Blue Devils got the "hit parade" started early.



20 After the first three batters got on base via a walk and two  
21 hit-by-pitches, John Daniel Deaton laced a fly ball over the head  
22 of Magee Centerfielder Chandler Pittman for an inside-the-park  
23 grand slam that gave Booneville a 4-0 lead. Every time Magee  
24 tried to get back in it, the Blue Devils (26-11) had an answer.  
25 After the Trojans got a run back in the bottom of the first,  
26 Booneville extended its lead to 6-1 in the second on a wild pitch  
27 and sacrifice fly. When Magee cut the lead to 6-3 on a two-run  
28 home run by Brennon McNair in the bottom of the third, the Blue  
29 Devils responded with four runs in the fourth, highlighted by  
30 Bryce Lindsey's two-run single, to take a 10-3 lead. Booneville  
31 added a run in the sixth and seventh to put the game away; and

32 WHEREAS, Ben Davis (8-3) got the win on the mound for the  
33 Blue Devils. The lineup pounded out nine hits and benefitted from  
34 seven walks and four bean balls. Ben Sandlin and Hayden Donahue  
35 both had two hits to lead Booneville offensively, but every  
36 starter either recorded a hit or walk, scored a run or brought one  
37 home. "Ben pitched like a veteran today and did a great job, our  
38 offense came through today and that's what we needed," Coach  
39 Williams said; and

50 community and to the State of Mississippi:

52 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That  
53 we do hereby commend and congratulate the Booneville High School  
54 "Blue Devils" Baseball Team and Head Coach Kevin Williams for  
55 winning the 2021 MHSAA Class 3A State Championship which is the  
56 second title in school history, and extend to the team, coaches,  
57 parents and sponsors our best wishes for future success.
