1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE
2 BOONEVILLE HIGH SCHOOL "BLUE DEVIL" MARCHING BAND AND DIRECTORS
3 JOSHUA AND JADA FORSYTHE FOR WINNING THE 2021 MHSAA 3A STATE
4 MARCHING CHAMPIONSHIP.

5 WHEREAS, we join the students, faculty, parents and the
6 Booneville Community in celebrating the outstanding achievement of
7 the Booneville High School "Blue Devil" Marching Band for winning
8 the Mississippi High School Activities Association (MHSAA) 3A
9 State Marching Championship on March 6, 2021; and

10 WHEREAS, the Booneville High School Band was named the MHSAA
11 3A State Marching Champion in 2021. This is the 12th State Title
12 for the band; and

13 WHEREAS, the Booneville High School Band has a long tradition
14 of excellence over the past five decades. It has one of the most
15 successful band programs in the state, boasting superior concert
16 ratings, an indoor Color Guard State Title, as well as 12 State
17 Marching Titles. The Blue Devil Band has won more State Marching
18 Championships than any other band in the state in any
19 classification, since the 2004 inception of Championships; and

21 Joshua and Jada Forsythe; and

22 WHEREAS, the Booneville High School Marching Band performs at
23 all home football games, concerts, school functions and contests
24 throughout the year; and

26 award-winning group of student athletes who have brought honor to
27 their school, their community and to the State of Mississippi:

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
29 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
30 we do hereby commend and congratulate the Booneville High School
31 "Blue Devil" Marching Band and Directors Joshua and Jada Forsythe
32 for winning the 2021 MHSAA 3A State Marching Championship, and
