| 8  | Activities Association (MHSAA) State Championships in a row in  |
| 9  | 2020, 2021 and 2022, giving them top two finishes in a row; and   |
| 10 | WHEREAS, the 2021 Girls Bowling Team was arguably the   |
| 11 | greatest high school girls bowling team in the history of the   |
| 12 | State of Mississippi. They competed in 12 tournaments and   |
| 13 | finished with a $12-0$ record in the tournaments and a $68-0$ record  |
| 14 | against all teams in those tournaments; and   |
| 15 | WHEREAS, the 2021 Lady Hawks also set the three-game pin-fall   |
| 16 | state record with a 2711 series; and  |

- 25 Young and Alissa McGill were members of all three State
- 26 Championship Teams. Hancock High School Coach Trevin Burge was
- 27 named the Mississippi Coach of the Year in 2021; and
