## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 603

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE  
2 PEARL RIVER COMMUNITY COLLEGE "WILDCATS" MEN'S BASKETBALL TEAM AND  
3 HEAD COACH CHRIS ONEY FOR WINNING ITS THIRD CONSECUTIVE MACCC  
4 TITLE.

5 WHEREAS, it took overtime to get it done, but the No. 22  
6 Pearl River Men's Basketball Team clinched its third consecutive  
7 Mississippi Association of Community Colleges Conference (MACCC)  
8 Title with a thrilling overtime 80-70 victory over No. 21  
9 Northeast Mississippi. The victory over the Tigers snapped their  
10 31-game home winning streak; and

11 WHEREAS, we knew going into the game that one streak had to  
12 end," Head Coach Chris Oney said. "It was either our conference  
13 winning streak or their home winning streak. "It's exciting to  
14 get to host the tournament for the college and for the town," he  
15 said; and

16 WHEREAS, the teams traded the lead off and on for most of the  
17 second half. Pearl River took a slim 59-57 lead after Jaronn  
18 Wilkens (Biloxi) was perfect from the free-throw line. Late in  
19 the game, Northeast reclaimed the lead 64-62, but Pearl River got



20 a clutch offensive rebound and put it back up to tie the score,  
21 64-64. Both teams had a chance at the end to win, but neither  
22 were able to convert, sending the game to overtime. In overtime,  
23 Pearl River jumped out to an early overtime lead to 74-66. The  
24 Wildcats rode the momentum to victory, defeating the Tigers by a  
25 final score of 80-70; and

26 WHEREAS, Cameron Brown led the way for the Wildcats with 19  
27 points, matching his season-high. He also finished with four  
28 rebounds and three assists. Earl Smith finished second on the  
29 team with 13 points, five rebounds and four assists. Jariyon  
30 Wilkens and Carlous Williams rounded out the Wildcats in double  
31 figures with 12 each. The 2022 Pearl River Community College
