- 7 Baseball Championship; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the Patriots (35-3, 14-1) ensured their victory with
- 9 a 5-1 win over Madison-Ridgeland Academy (27-11, 5-2) on May 12,
- 10 2021. Jackson Prep swept the best-of-three championship series in
- 11 two games at its home field; and
- 12 WHEREAS, "It feels great," Jackson Prep Baseball Coach Brent
- 13 Heavener said. "After last year with COVID and everything we
- 14 dealt with and the seniors went through. Four in a row, I
- 15 couldn't be more proud of them. These guys don't know how to
- 16 lose." Jackson Prep had a 2-1 lead before Mississippi State
- 17 signee Jeffrey Ince belted a three-run home run in the bottom of
